15. Bryn y Gorlan 5 (fig. 8; surveyed 1979) SN 75 SW 7488 5463
 Lying on a plateau at 450 m OD on ground falling away very gently to the SW. The site consists of a discontinuous ring of upright and leaning slabs surrounding a grass-grown interior towards the centre of which is a single leaning slab. The overall diameter is less than 3 m. On the N the slabs are contiguous but on the S the ring is broken by a gap of 1.5 m. A large quartz boulder lies embedded just outside the ring, but adjacent to it, on the SE. A low grass-grown mound on the immediate E is probably robbing spoil. The site lies 100 m SW of a stone circle (Leighton 1980).
