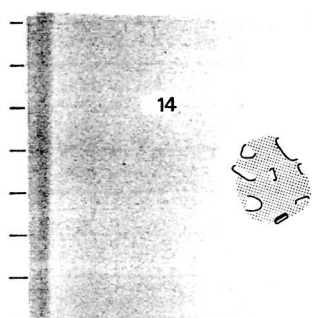


## AUTHORITY

— Lying at 400 m O.D. on the top of a narrow ridge on the dissected W scarp of a plateau. The site consists of seven leaning and fallen slabs surrounding an oval interior and measuring, overall, 2.8 m × 2.5 m. The interior is grass-grown with a height of only a few centimetres. A single fallen slab lies at the centre. This site is one of a number of structures which lie on the plateau at the foot of which lie field banks and a ruined rectangular building (Leighton, 1980).
