

13. Bryn Rhudd (fig. 8; surveyed 1981) SN 65 NE 6899 5555
Situating at 445 m OD on a shelf on sloping ground in a saddle between two ridges, overlooked on the NE and W but with a view over the Breifi valley to the S. The cairn is an oval mound of grass and heather-consolidated stones and measures 8 m (E-W) x 7 m with a height of 0.5 m. Within the cairn mass is an oval setting of large slabs mainly upright or outward-leaning. The ring is discontinuous on the SE where the cairn is most obviously disturbed. A ruined cist lies at the centre of the mound.
