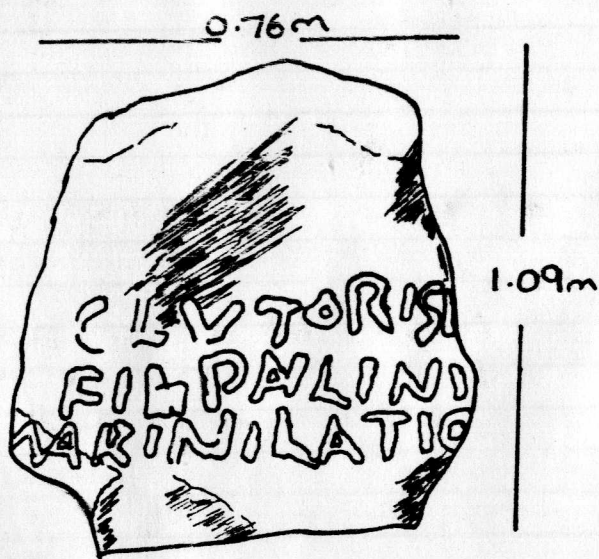

One of these stones, now built into the wall of the church, was dug up in 1827, a tradition of its existence having been preserved in the parish. (See Lewis's Topographical Dictionary). For the three stones see Arch. Camb. III, vi, 53; V, xiii, 135 and 291; and V, xv, 275. There are some curious cuts on a stone built into the east wall near the window.

Inscribed stone with Latin inscription.

"To CLUTORIX son of Paunus marcus of Latium", ~~was~~ incorporated into the external south wall of the nave.
