

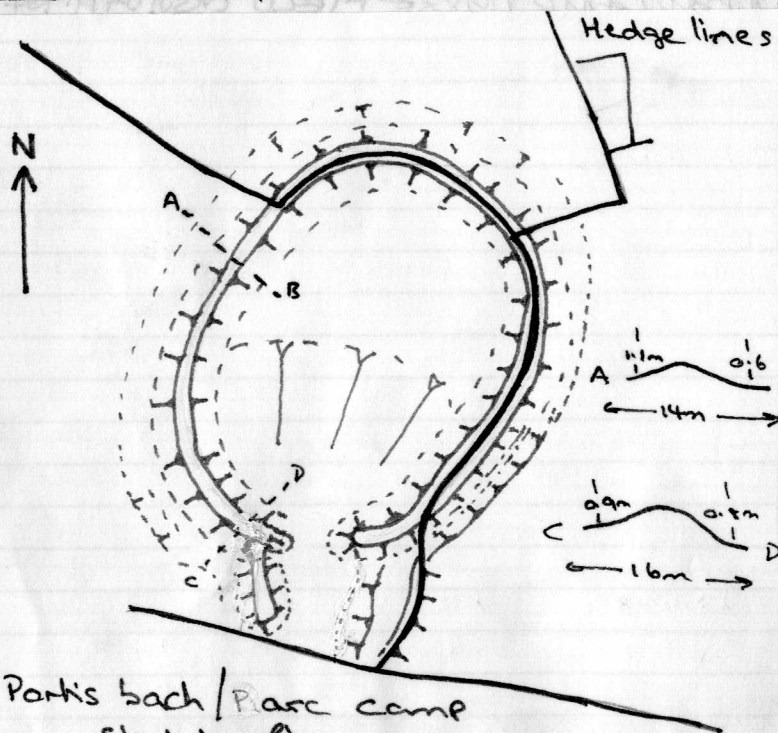
Portis Parc: Bach camp.

The well preserved remains of a probable Iron age camp, oval in shape standing 167 metres above sea level, with good views all around. In a field on Portis bach Farm.

The site consists of a single broad bank, shale & earth constructed c 14-16m wide, and up to 2 metres high in places. Traces of a ditch can be seen around the site, especially on the north & east sides.

Entrance into the site is at the south through a annexed enclosure bounded by a bank on its east & west sides. The interior of the camp is level until the southern part, where the ground then falls gently towards the entrance. Hedge bank has been constructed on top of the bank on its northern & eastern side of the camp.
