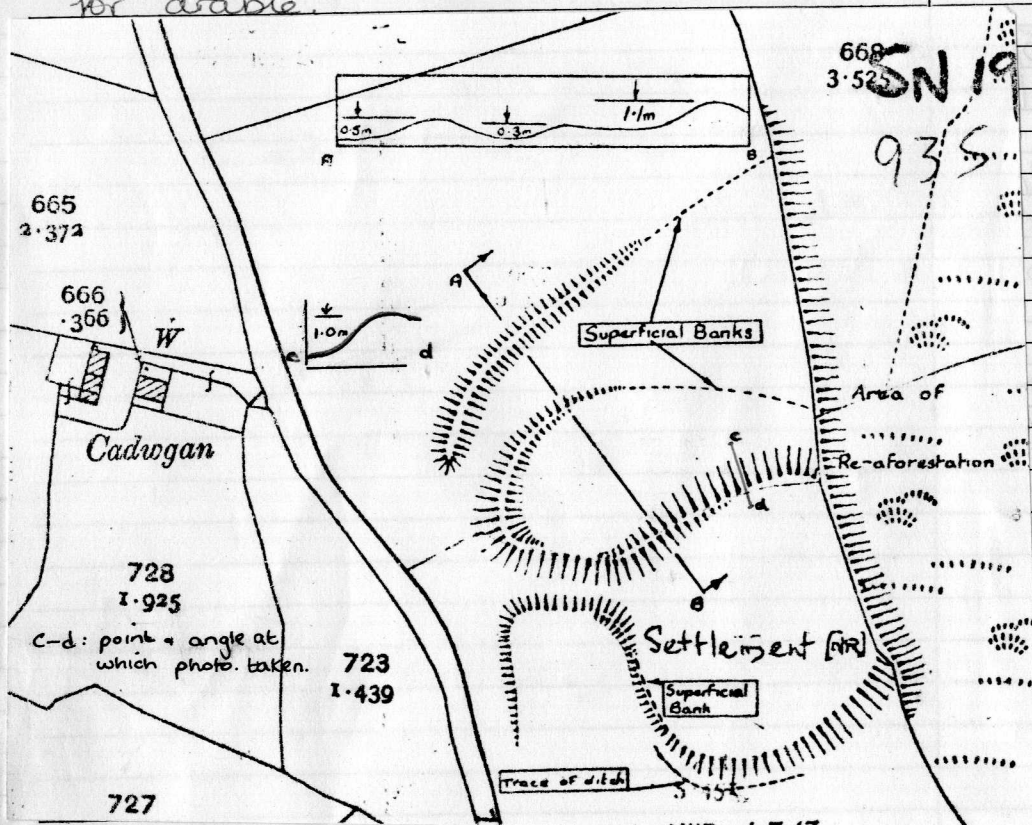


Gelli Dogyn earthwork is an Iron Age sub-rectangular enclosure situated on a south facing hillside in an arable field. The defences are ploughed down but still visible. They include two banks to the north & one bank to the south and west the east side being protected by steep natural slopes. There is a hollow-way entrance at the west side. It is regularly ploughed for arable.
