

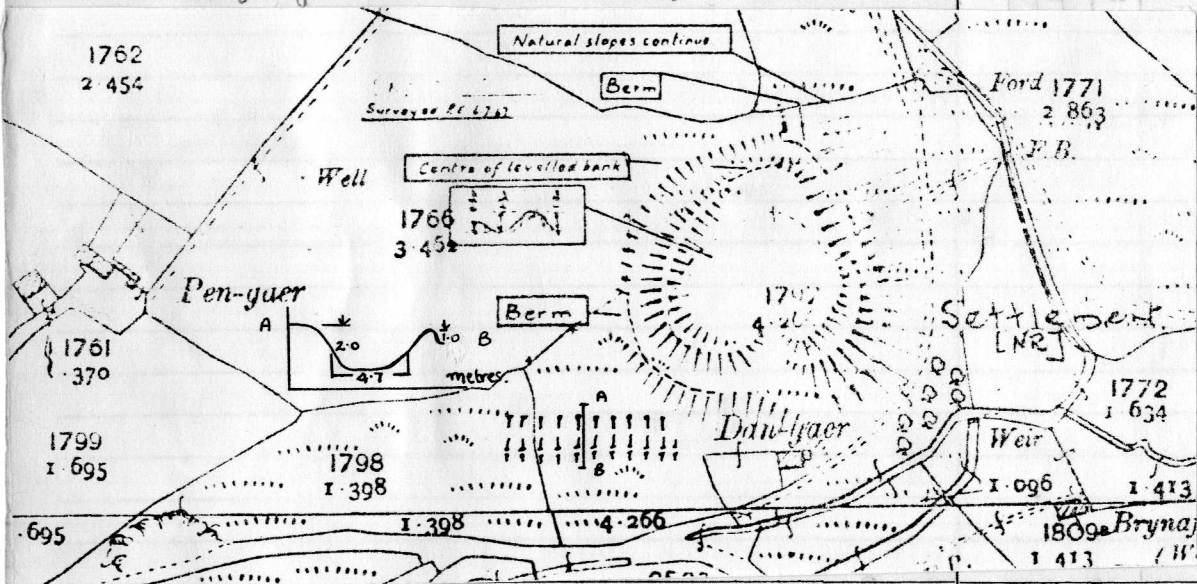
This is a small promontory enclosure, roughly triangular in shape and protected to the north and west by a strong single bank and ditch and to the south and east by a weak bank falling onto steep natural slopes. The south and east defences are overgrown with trees and bracken & the slopes are now densely wooded.

The entrance is at the south end.

The hedgebank to the west of the enclosure has been removed and a fence extends across the bank on the south and east sides.

A section of the north bank has been levelled and its outer ditch filled in.

To the SW of the enclosure there is a ditch and small outer bank extending across in a west to east direction. Its location is sketched in on the OS Plan; its connection, if any, with the enclosure has yet to be established.
