COMMENT **AUTHORITY** 11 No. 16 Henllys Camp 952 Castell Henllys crowns the top of high hill overlooking Glanduad. This hill is now covered by a flourishing plantation. On the south side of the camp is a scarp of about 30 feet, at the bottom of which is a levelled surface of about 30 ft wide. This green road rises and forms an entrance to the camp on the eastern side. The northern front is defended by a bank which rises above the level of the camp, a very deep ditch, and an outside bank. The western side appears never to have been completed. A mound (perhaps natural) in one place reaches up to the level of the northern bank, and causes a similarity between Castell Henllys and the Nevern series of fortifications.
