The camp is circular, about 22 yards in diameter, with only one bank, with an outside ditch, which is now nearly obliterated. The bank is about 13 feet high from the bottom of the ditch. It is an earthen castellum raised above the surface. The entrance was on the east. The camp is known as BLAEN LECHOG, the "source of the stony stream".
