Ruined Church

Far away from any house this little ruin stands. It is 23 ft by 15, and not much more than the foundation remains. In George Owen's day it was a curacy "In the Kinges mates handes" and was annexed to Penrydd Parish. It was formerly one of the possessions of Slebech Commandery: Owen's Pembrokeshire, p. 297. In 1842 the chapel was in ruins but the incumbent of the parish received an annual payment of 1 guinea from Sir R.B. Philipps, Bart. of Picton Castle. See Lewis's Top. Dic. It is called ECCLESIA DE CASTELTH-LAN in TAXATIO.
