Considerable change since 1969 (1).
The then relatively well preserved ~~area~~
~~portion~~ part in the NE field has
now been covered with dumped
soil & is under cultivation. This
should afford protection to the
archaeological levels, although the
top of the bank may suffer. The
portion in the SE field is now even
further reduced & almost ploughed out.
The western part is somewhat reduced
since 1969, but still traceable.
