A probable round barrow c.14m in diameter and c. 50cm high, in a field which has been reclaimed from rough pasture by ploughing and reseeded within the last decade. It is now a flat-topped mound with an irregular surface and edge, perhaps as a result of the clearance process. It is turfed over but a few stones protrude. It is sited at the S. edge of the flattish summit of the 700' hill which rises to the NE of Meini Gwyr (990) and may be false crested in terms of an approach from the S. PRN 1013 lies only c. 100m to the SW, in roughly the same direction as Meini Gwyr at the base of the hill.

Probable round barrow situated in a Pasture Field c. 15 metres EW by 14 metres N-S. c. 0.5m high. mound Flat-topped with several small to medium sized stones protruding through the surface, especially in the northern half of the barrow
