The remnants of a mound apparently cut through on its W side by the A478 road, probably when the latter was rebuilt as a turnpike in the 19th Cent. This left the mound in an isolated strip of land too narrow for cultivation. The S edge of the mound is crossed by a field boundary. To the N is a corrugated iron shed- the space between is left waste but may have been disturbed by intermittent digging of rubbish pits. The surviving mound is c.25m in diam. and c.1m high (estimates)
