About 75 m to the S of PRN 9773<sup>27</sup> and in a similar situation, ie, truncated by the A4 A478 to the W and owing its survival to being thereby left isolated in a plot too narrow for cultivation. However, in <sup>me</sup>last 2-3 years it has been subject to rotovator cultivation for potatoes etc. The mound is distinctly stonier (with much quartz) than the surrounding ground and the crop do not do well on it. Its diameter is c. 20 m and its height c. 50 cm. (estimates)
