

Early church site at
 Great Castle Head mentioned
 during conversation with J P
 Gordon-Williams^① just before his
 death. He mentioned a
 church site "near St ~~St~~ Ichnaels
 Lighthouse", ~~for which~~
 associated with possible cist
 graves and an ECM - the
 latter bearing a cross, a chi-ro
 and bow and arrow symbol,
 and lodged in Haverfordwest
 Museum. The information
 was obviously garbled and
 exaggerated, however, the existence
 of a church at Old Castle
 Head is also mentioned by Gordon-
 Williams in the St Ichnaels church
 guide^②, presumably a product of his
 younger and more vibrant days. ~~●~~
