### **Location :**

Between 2 field gates on the N side of a minor road between Llanddowror and Tavernspite, approximately 3.6km WSW of Llanddowror village.

### **History**

C19 stone on the boundary between Llandowror and Eglwys Cymun parishes, marked on the 1888 OS map.

### **Exterior**

Boundary stone in the form of a dressed limestone slab with splayed front. Each of the 2 facets has a a rounded top. On each face is an incised hand with finger pointing L and R respectively, and engraved 'Eglwys Cymmyn Parish' on the L and 'Landowror [sic] Parish' on the R.

### **Interior**

### **Listed**

Listed as a well-lettered boundary stone, one of several similar boundary stones in west Carmarthenshire and eastern Pembrokeshire, and as one of a pair of stones marking the boundary of Llanddowror Parish.
