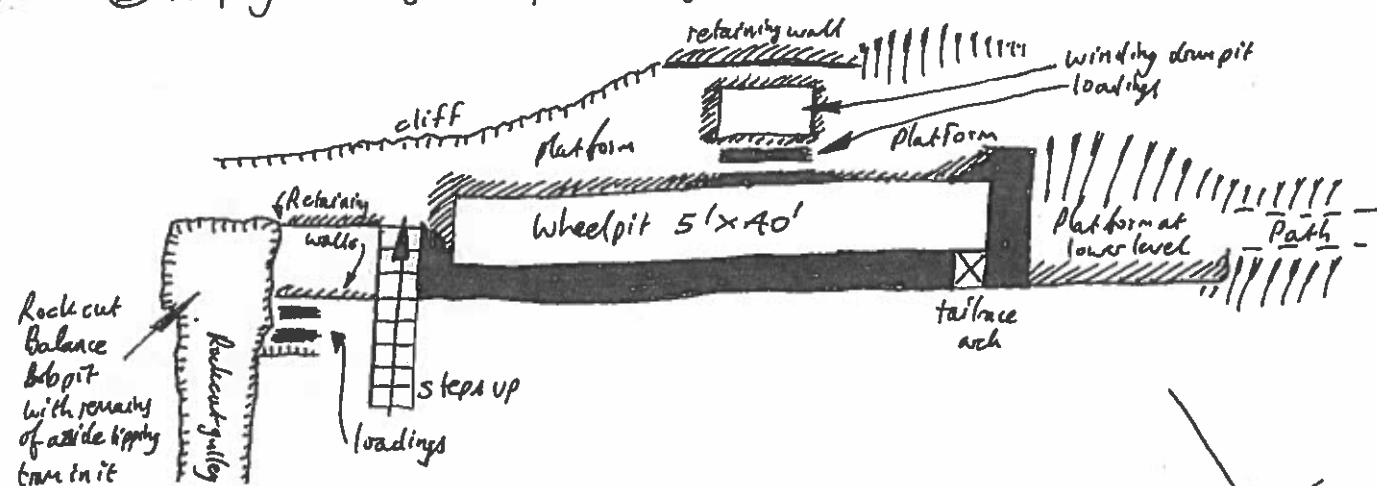


Visited 20.III.1993.

PRN

- 96054 ① Embanked mine pit; grass-grown.
- 96055 ② Gully on site of waterwheel tailrace
- 96056 ③ Crusher waste and grass-grown tip from excavation of wheelpits
- 96057 ④ Lower wheelpit 4'x18'; shaft completely infilled
- 96058 ⑤ Upper wheelpit 5'x22'; reasonable condition but broken down at SE end. Fragment of crusher house to NW. Two arched openings in NW end wall.
- 96059 ⑥ No trace of boulders
- 96060 ⑦ Building outlines
- 96061 ⑧ Rock cut level; open; wet; fairly large
- 96062 ⑨ Vegetated development rock tip
- 96063 ⑩ Rock cut level; open; wet; Branches into two at entrance. NE branch is a little small & only 10' long; NW branch is fairly large.
- 96064 ⑪ Barely tactile site of building
- 96065 ⑫ Slope come to surface; rock cut; irregular; open; 15' deep to infill but slopes off SW to a greater depth.
- 96066 ⑬ Rock cut level; open; 2' of water in entrance; remains of metal gate installed just inside entrance; ~~fairly large~~ ^{moderate} cross section.
- 96067 ⑭ Readily tactile tunnel alignment from level ⑬ towards crusher.
- 96068 ⑮ Rock cut level; open; dry; moderate cross section. Enters shaft ⑯
- 96069 ⑯ Engine shaft; rock cut; 11'x8'; remains of masonry angle bobpit to SE; some studs projecting from ground ^{just} to SW. Open but blocked by refuse at 25' depth, from which an 8" rising man projects by 4' adjacent to where level ⑮ enters shaft; pumpthy spear projects from man but has been bent down into refuse in shaft. Collapsed metalwork from a bob in W. corner of refuse infill in shaft.
- 96070 ⑰ Development rock tips; coarse; some cupriforous vein stuff and galena. No trace of a rod from lower wheelpit
- 96071 ⑱ Very ruinous remains of building.
- 96072 ⑲ Rocky gully; maximum depth 20'; average 10' width.
- 96073 ⑳ Grassy tips

96074 ② Pumping & windy wheelpit in a good state of preservation:



All details sketched on site

19830 ② Well defined lead

96075 ③ Slight gully is only trace of flat rods/windy rope route to shaft to west or east

38166 { ④ Caved in crater and 12' x 16' rock cut shaft blocked by refuse at 20' depth; slight remains of angle bob pit to NE
⑤ Vegetated large development rock tip
