

Visited 19.II.1993.

- 6016 (1) Leat in good condition.  
6016 (2) Impressive rock cut section of leat on steep hillside  
6017 (3) Western shaft; seems choked at a shallow depth; rockcut; grass grown development rock tip. Tree branches etc. dumped in top.  
6018 (4) Deep Adit Level: not visited.  
(5) Minor grassy tip from excavation of Pumping Wheel pit.  
(6) Pumping wheel pit: 5'x30' partly filled in; south end wall demolished. No trace of southern balance bob pit; studs projecting from infilled site of northern balance bob pit.  
6020 (7) Demolished remains of culvert carrying flat rods under road.  
6021 (8) Four studs here: probably site of an angle bob.  
6022 (9) Remains of dolly wheel stand.  
6023 (10) Stud and slight rock gulley where flat rods crossed leat.  
6016 (11) Leat in good condition.  
6024 (12) Two minor trenches on leote; minor hollows to east. Grassy dumps.  
6025 (13) Small rockcut open shaft.  
6026 (14) <sup>Taylor's</sup> Engine shaft: opens into slope; very cratered; some masonry fragments; remains of wheeled flat rod on collapsed site of angle bob pit - probably one of the lengths of flat rod from the summit section of the run of flat rods dragged nearer the shaft when the rods ran into the shaft & its collapse cone. Grassy tips.  
6027 (15) Small refuse choked shaft.  
6028 (16) Eastern shaft: narrow slope come to surface; open.  
- (17) Small collapse crater.  
6029 (18) Quarry & associated tips  
6030 (19) No trace of building.  
6031 (20) Very ruined buildings - probably mine office etc.  
6032 (21) Run-in level  
6033 (22) Stone arched level portal, almost totally infilled.  
6034 (23) Fairly grassy development rock tips.  
6035 (24) Winding Wheel Pit. Good condition though south end wall demolished. See sketch on page 2.  
6036 (25) No trace of rods/winding rope route.  
6037 (26) Rockcut level and entrance cuttby. Open.

- 6038 (27) Very ruinous magazine.
- 6039 (28) 2 Very ruinous ore bins. Walls & structures to either side razed.
- 6040 (29) No trace of building.
- 6041 (30) 4' x 16' wheelpit. Fairly good condition but almost filled in.
- 6042 (31) Stone arched level: almost totally filled in.
- 6043 (32) Main development <sup>coarse</sup> & waste dumps.
- 6044 (33) Two areas of very fine dumps:
- 6045 (34) 6' high retaining wall.
- 6046 (35) 4' x 30' fairly intact wheelpit; virtually no trace of crusher house or other adjacent buildings.
- 6047 (36) Very ruinous building.
- 6048 (37) No trace of building.
- 6049 (38) Slight retaining wall; site of position of 2 boulders marked on 2nd. edn. O.S. disconable.
- 6050 (39) 2' retaining wall.
- 6051 (40) Slight remains of boulder shown on 2nd. edn. O.S. Just to east is a wooden shoot structure projecting from fine dump.
- 6052 (41) Area of fairly fine waste.
- 6053 (42) Very ruinous fragments of crusher & wheelpit.
