Oct 1968 - ----- 13/E2 (admin Identity only – not used operationally)

1982 Letter/Number identities ceased – Operational Numbers only used

Sept 1938 – May 1945 – Standard Hut + commencing with Self-Build

Replaced if required by permanent structure during war.

May 1945 – Jan 1947 Site not officially used

Jan 1947 - 1960 Original Observation Post reused.

Mar 1961 – Sep 1991 Standard ROC Monitoring Post in use.

HEIGHT above Sea level of Monitoring Post + 200ft (61m from 1987)
