

Renovation and repair of castle terraces

A COUNCILLOR has praised the work being done to maintain the hill-sides surrounding Haverfordwest's Norman castle.

The terraced walls below Haverfordwest castle have fallen into disrepair in recent years, but work to rebuild them and keep them clear of weeds has now begun.

PCC officers have started to clear the banks and rebuild the stone walls through June and July.
