Location On outskirts of Templeton Village

Directions to reach the Post (to be detailed and explicit, assuming that the person following the directions has no knowledge of the area and is travelling in the most direct route from Group Headquarters. Include a sketch map on the reverse of these instructions).

On leaving Group HQ turn left and take the A40 (West) until you arrive at St Clears. At St Clears continue on the A40 towards Haverfordwest (passing through Whitland then Llanddewi Velfrey) until you come to the Penblewin roundabout (the junction of the A40-A478). Turn left onto the A487 towards Tenby (passing through Narberth). After passing through Narberth continue for about two miles until you reach Templeton. Take the first right at the ton of the village opposite the Bus Shelter. follow this road (keeping the bungalows to your left) for approximately 500 yards, and the Post should be seen on the left. The Post is on the side of the road, and can be recognised by a small galvanised gate with approximately ten feet of chain link fencing.
