



C. Description of monument

The monument comprises a triangular shaped standing stone which appears to have been used as a gate post more recently (indicated by two hanging posts on the southern face of the stone). The fact that lichen is only found in the top half of the monument indicates it has been moved from its original location and would have been positioned at a deeper level below current ground level. The standing stone is not noted on the 1889 county survey map, suggesting that it was moved after this time. The length of lichen coverage also suggests that the stone was in place for a long period of time in its original location.


