## 2. Site Context

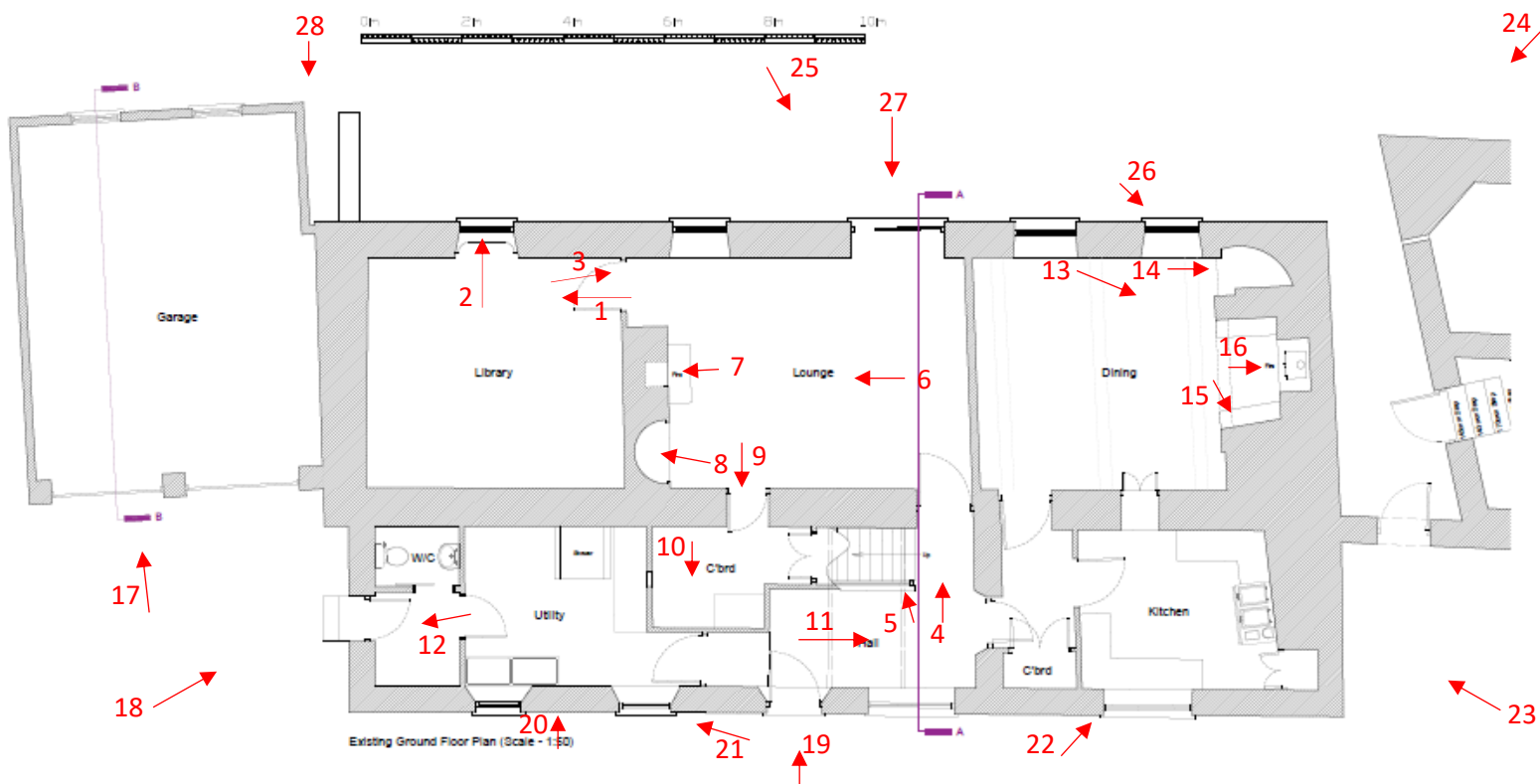
Manor House is located within the small, rural village of Wiston in Pembrokeshire and is located adjacent to Wiston Castle. The site is accessed from the south via a stone wall entrance that is capped by quoin stones with a single-track access lane that loops in front (west) of the property.

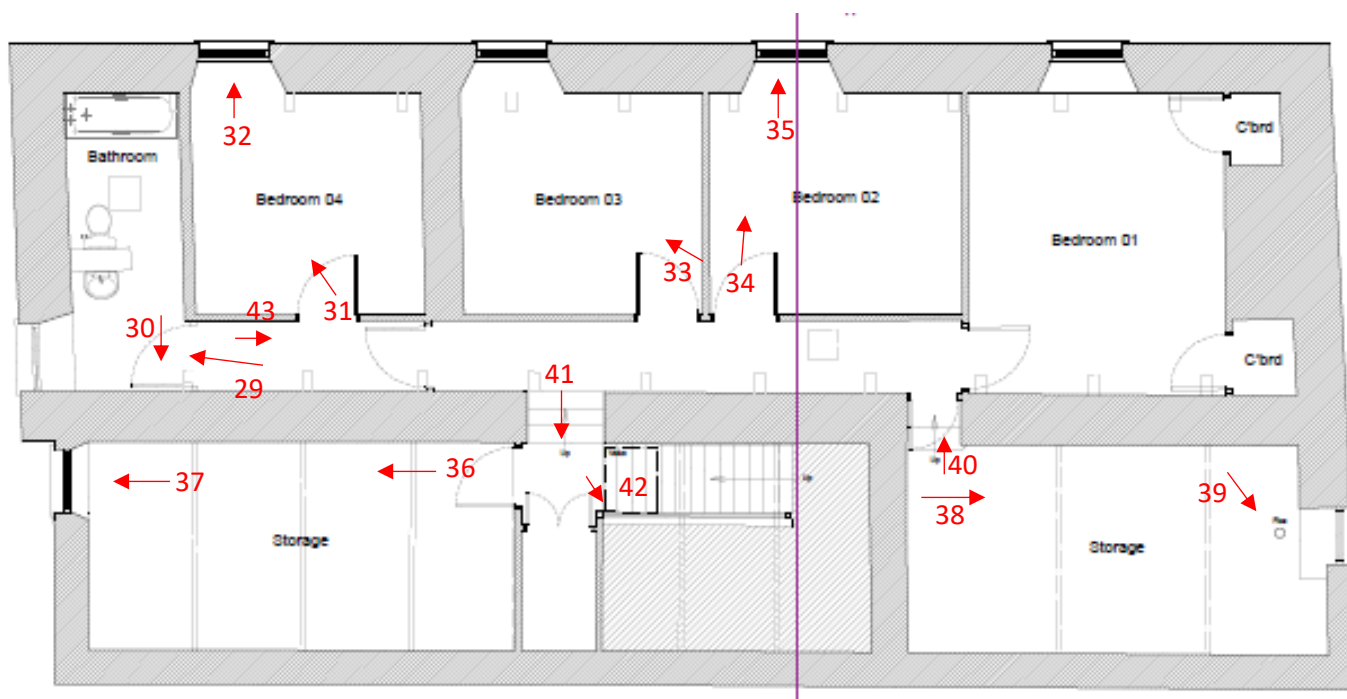
The property at Manor House comprises of two separate buildings, the main dwelling which is the subject of this photographic survey and the barn building, south of the dwelling at Manor House.

The Manor House dwelling is a two-storey 4-bedroom building with a natural slate catslide roof that slopes to the front of the property and consists of whitewash coursed field stones at the front and sides (north and south) of the property with non-coloured coursed field stones at the rear (east) of the building.

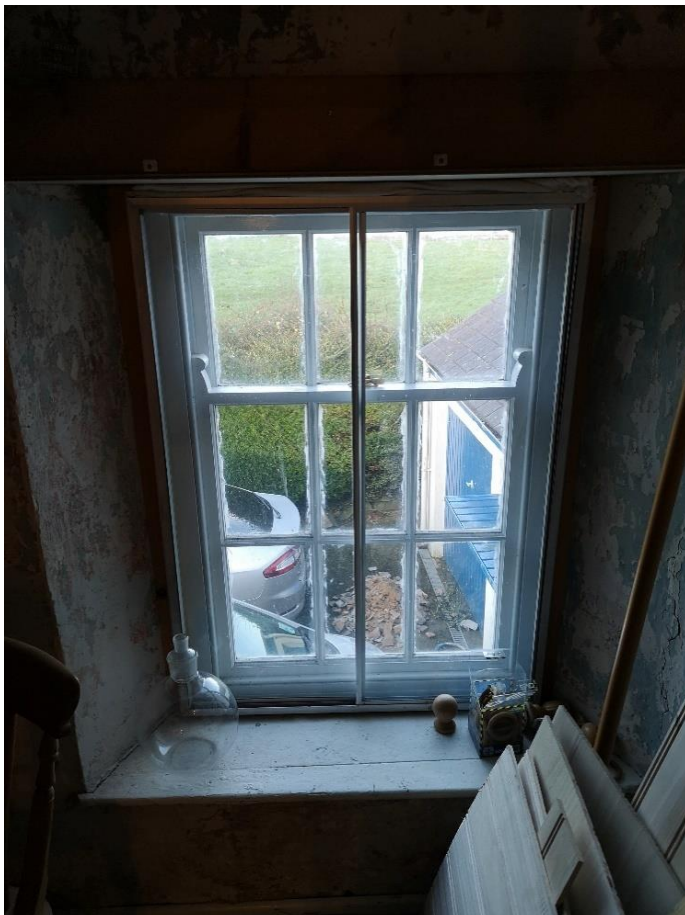
