Part One includes a synthesis of the results of fieldwork carried out by Trysor in the South Cambrian Mountains study area in 2011-2012.


Part Two includes location maps and the site gazetteer based on the findings of the fieldwork.

The site gazetteer itself is a copy of the information in the project database submitted to the RCAHMW in digital format.







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











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







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
Map 6: Esgair Tanlan and Crug Siarls


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
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
Map 7: Bryn Glas






Map 9: Cefn Gwenffrwd and Penrhiwiar







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


Map 11: Banc Rhiw Fawr





Map 12: Mynydd Mallaen






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


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
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
Map 16: Esgair Ferchon
