	Planting of two areas (2ha & 0.4ha) of improved grassland at 120m a.s.l. Brown
Brief description of new planting site	earth soils. The larger area is steeply sloping with a westerly aspect and borders an existing mixed broadleaved/conifer woodland. The smaller area is a wet field edge.
Pre-planting ground preparation	Pre-plant spot spraying with herbicide to provide weed free planting area.
Design of new planting scheme	Native Woodland – Biodiversity. Lowland Mixed Broadleaved Woodland W10. Group planting of individual species to allow for different growth rates. Rides & glades will be created through the woodland for the benefit of local bat & bird populations.
Type of planting stock and size of trees/shrubs	Bare root transplants (1+1 or 1u1). Trees 30-50cm.
Tree protection – what type of tree shelters/spiral guards will be used and why?	No pests currently so individual tree protection unnecessary. However, spiral guards 50mm diameter and 60cm tall will be used to protect slower growing trees from rabbits, mice and voles if it becomes necessary. The guards will be supported by 90cm bamboo canes (12-14lb per 100).
Fencing (livestock)	Boundaries adjoining grazed fields will be stockfenced to the Glastir specification to protect the trees from animals.

Open ground	There will be a network of rides through the planting with some small glades upto the maximum 15% of open ground allowed. Slower growing trees will be planted closer together to ensure the minimum stocking rate of 1,600 trees per hectare is exceeded.

Are standing trees present?	There are standing trees around the Southern edge of both planting areas. New trees will not generally be planted under the canopy of existing trees. Trees will be planted at a narrower spacing to compensate for not planting under the drip line of existing edge trees.

I agree to repay, on demand, any overpayments made to me as a result of a miscalculation by the Welsh Government or otherwise.

I will allow duly authorised officers of the Welsh Government, or their duly authorised agents, access to any land or any woodland areas included in the Woodland Creation Plan in order to inspect the land, any relevant equipment, storage facilities and records (including computer records), and any other aspect of the land within the Woodland Creation Plan in order to verify the accuracy of the information in this application, and I will give them all reasonable assistance for that purpose.

I understand that if my application is successful, I will be required to enter into a Glastir Woodland Creation Contract and payment of any grant funding will be conditional on compliance with the terms of that contract. If I am offered a contract and do not enter into the agreement, or fulfil the terms of the contract I may be excluded form re-applying for Glastir Woodland Creation for the following two calendar years.

I understand that the use of an agent or Management Planner does not affect my personal responsibility for the accuracy of the information provided in this application, nor does it absolve me of responsibility to comply with the terms of any contract should my application be successful.

I understand that I must not commence project activity, before I have received written confirmation from the Welsh Government to do so. Any expenditure incurred before the approval date is at my own risk and may render the project ineligible for support.
