2a. Management Objectives

To obtain the maximum financial return from the growing crop by the practice of sound silviculture and growing quality timber.

To maintain and where viable enhance woodland biodiversity benefits within the limited confines of the site

To manage the forest in accordance with the UK Forestry Standard

2b. Site description

Blaenhenfod Fach is an isolated 2.9ha block of Japanese larch located 3km south of Llanybydder at SN 524 410, OS map sheet number 146. Access is via an unclassified track which ends at a farmhouse just beyond the woodland. The larch block lies on a moderately steep east facing slope, with an altitude ranging from 200 to 250 metres. The surrounding landscape comprises a patchwork of agricultural fields, small wooded blocks and the more extensive conifer plantations of Brechfa Forest to the south east.

There are no public foot paths in the area and the adjacent access track only services the single farm house to the south, for which clear access will need to be maintained throughout the proposed harvesting operation.

There are no SAMs or other recorded historic features in the vicinity though DAT consultation will be carried out to further assess this.

There are no watercourses crossing the site and no designated features within the property.

5a. Long term vision for restoration

Restocking of the *Phytophthora* infected larch will produce a highly productive timber crop through the planting of discrete areas of Douglas fir and Sitka spruce with the broadleaf element located to produce a soft edge against the road running along the western boundary of the woodland.

Fell & restock	Clearfell infected larch and restock with a GWR Capital Works 619 compliant species mixture of 50% Douglas fir, 40% Sitka spruce, 10% Mixed Broadleaves.	An established restock crop at 2,500 stems per hectare, comprising 50% Douglas fir, 40% SS and 10% birch / cherry.
Stock fencing	The woodland is surrounded by agricultural fields and the existing fences are in a variable condition.
