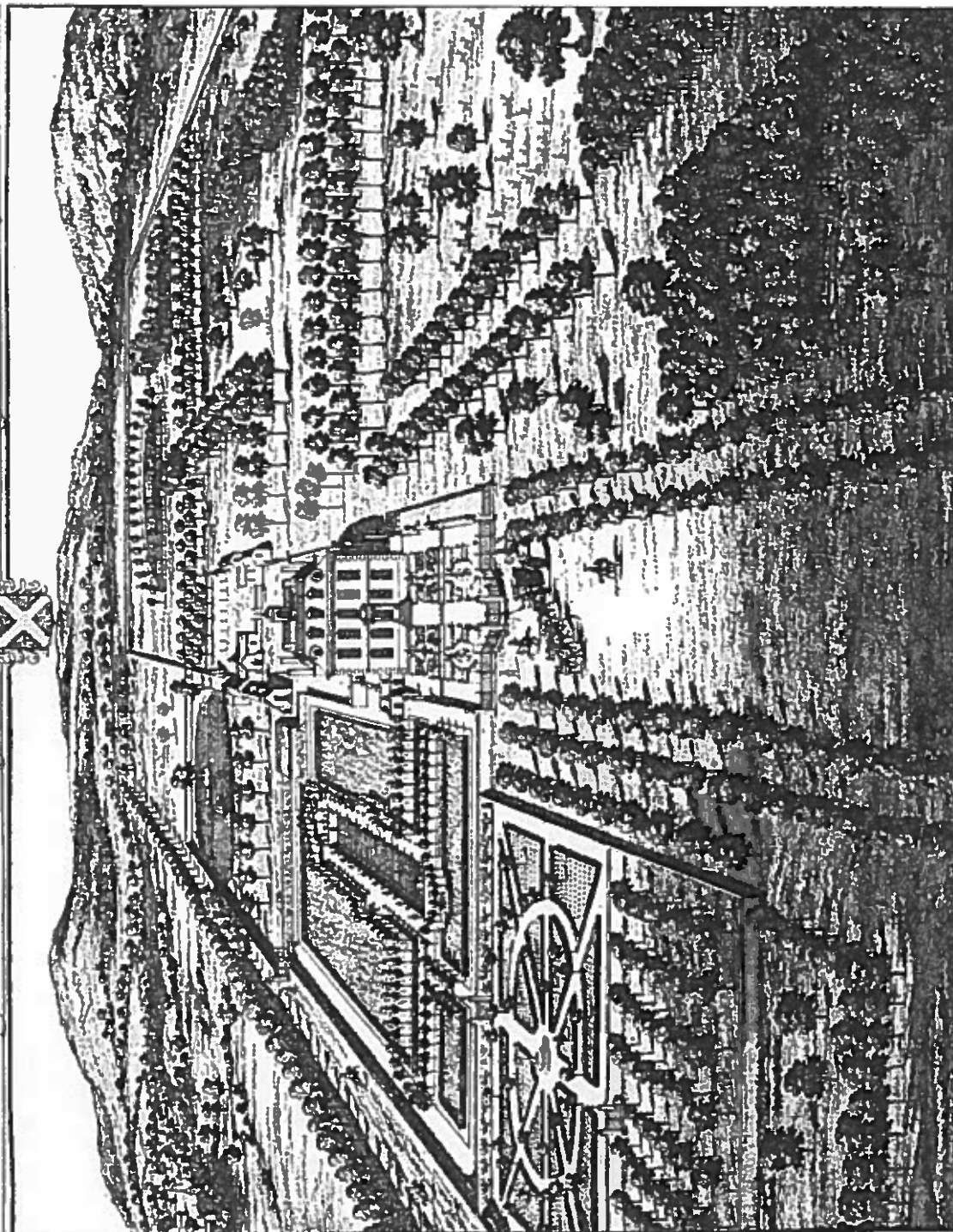

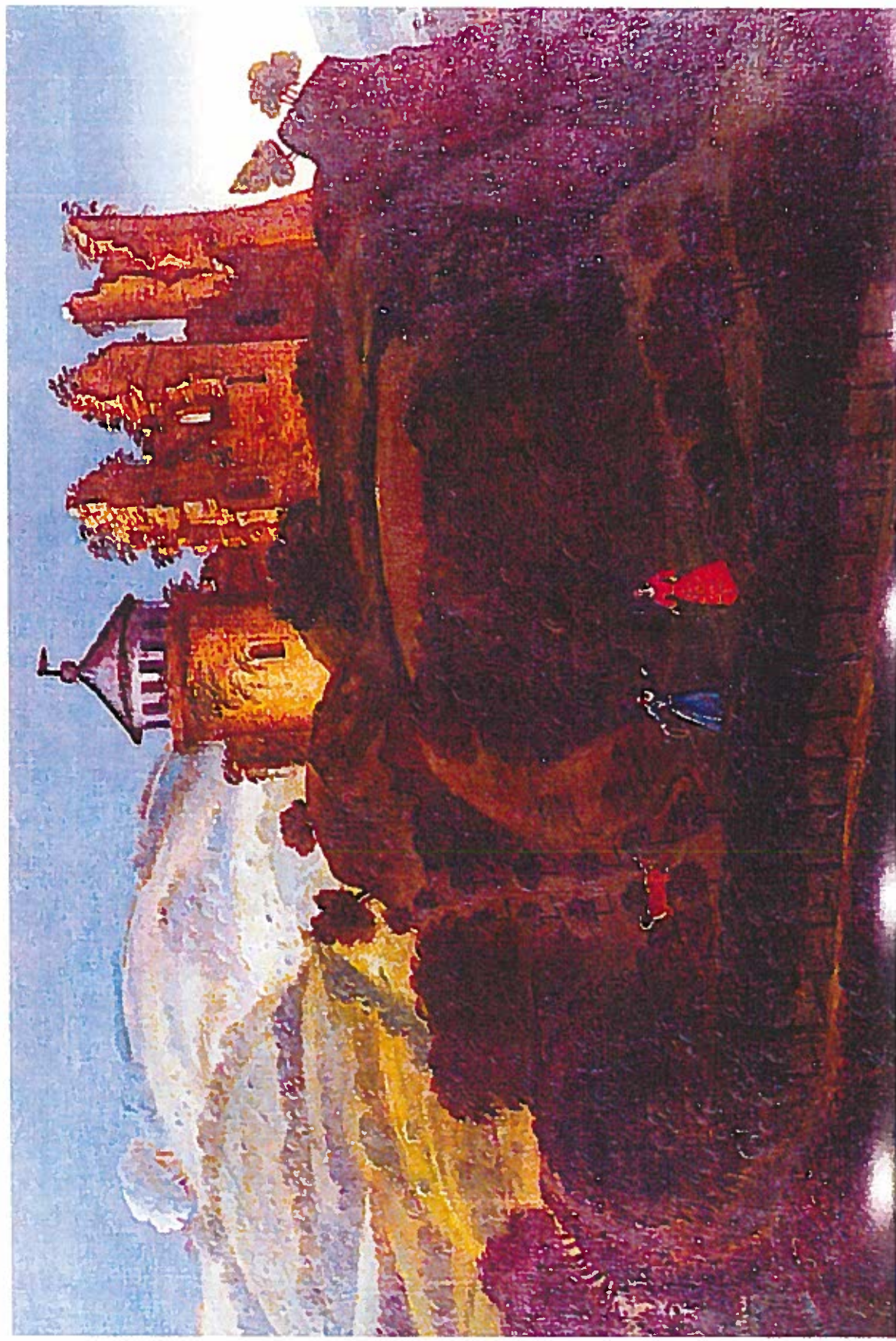

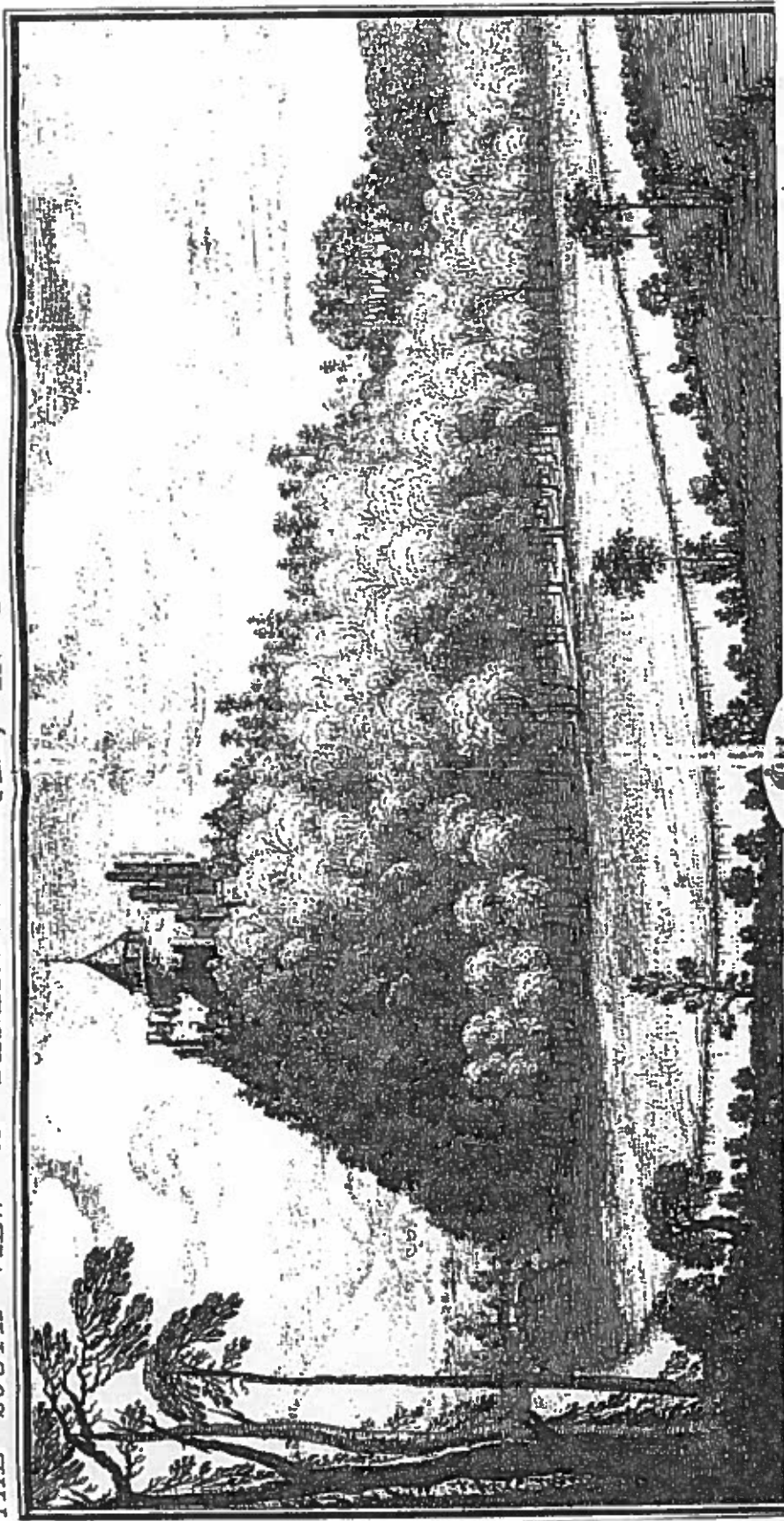

THE SOUTH VIEW OF DENEFAWR-CASTLE, IN THE COUNTY OF CAERMARTHEN.



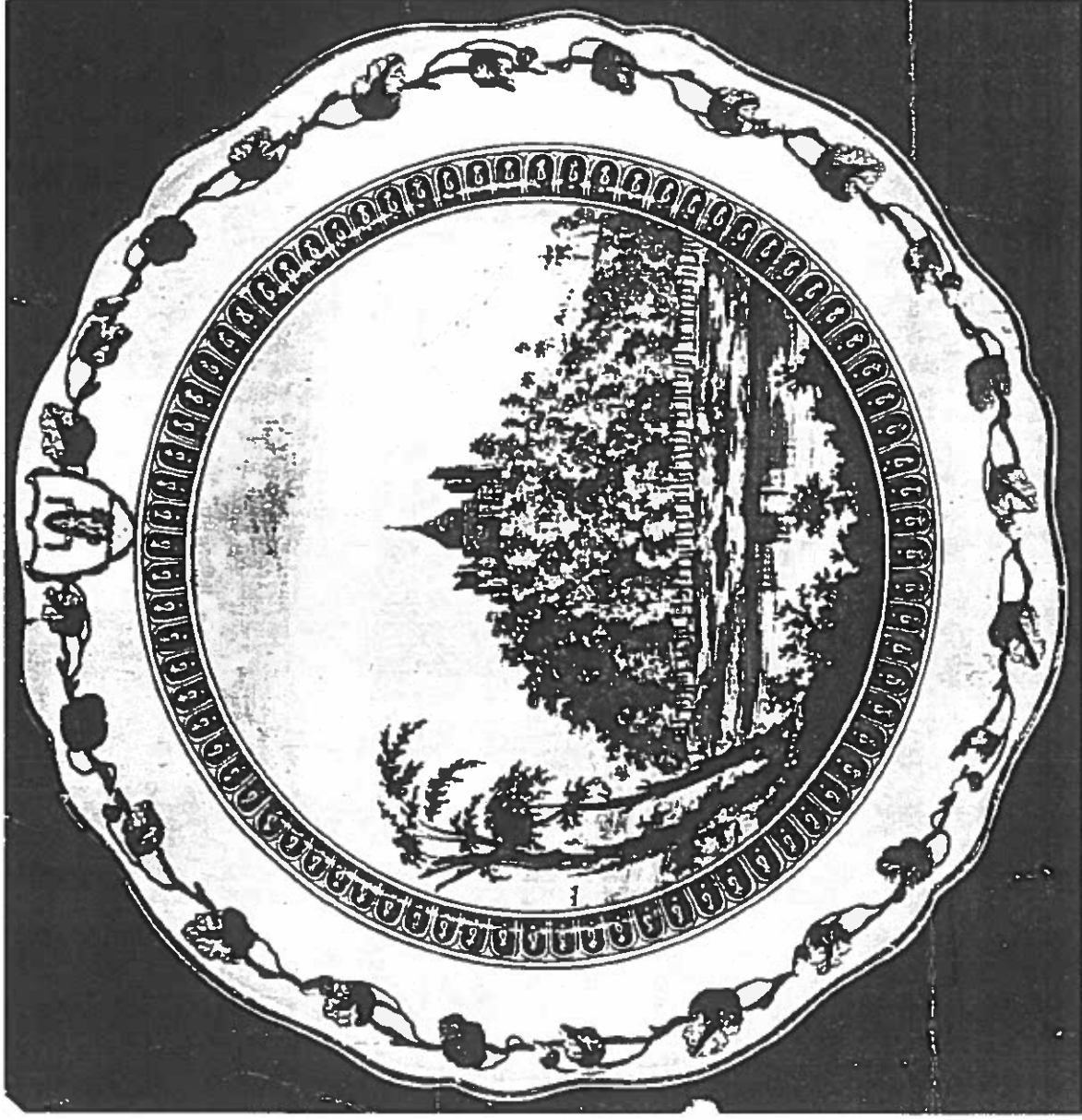
THESE Castle is situated on a Top of a Hill by the River Savoy about ten Miles East of Worcester. It was by Royal and private Survey of South Wales what they call Worcester's Moor. It being at its Head often with at length falling to the Crown King Henry the 7th made a Grant of it to three Knights, Henry the 8th of the 1st Order, in whose Palace it still continues, present Lord being George Clifford, 3rd Duke of Northumberland. Bishop Becket's tombing place of Worcester is just by it.

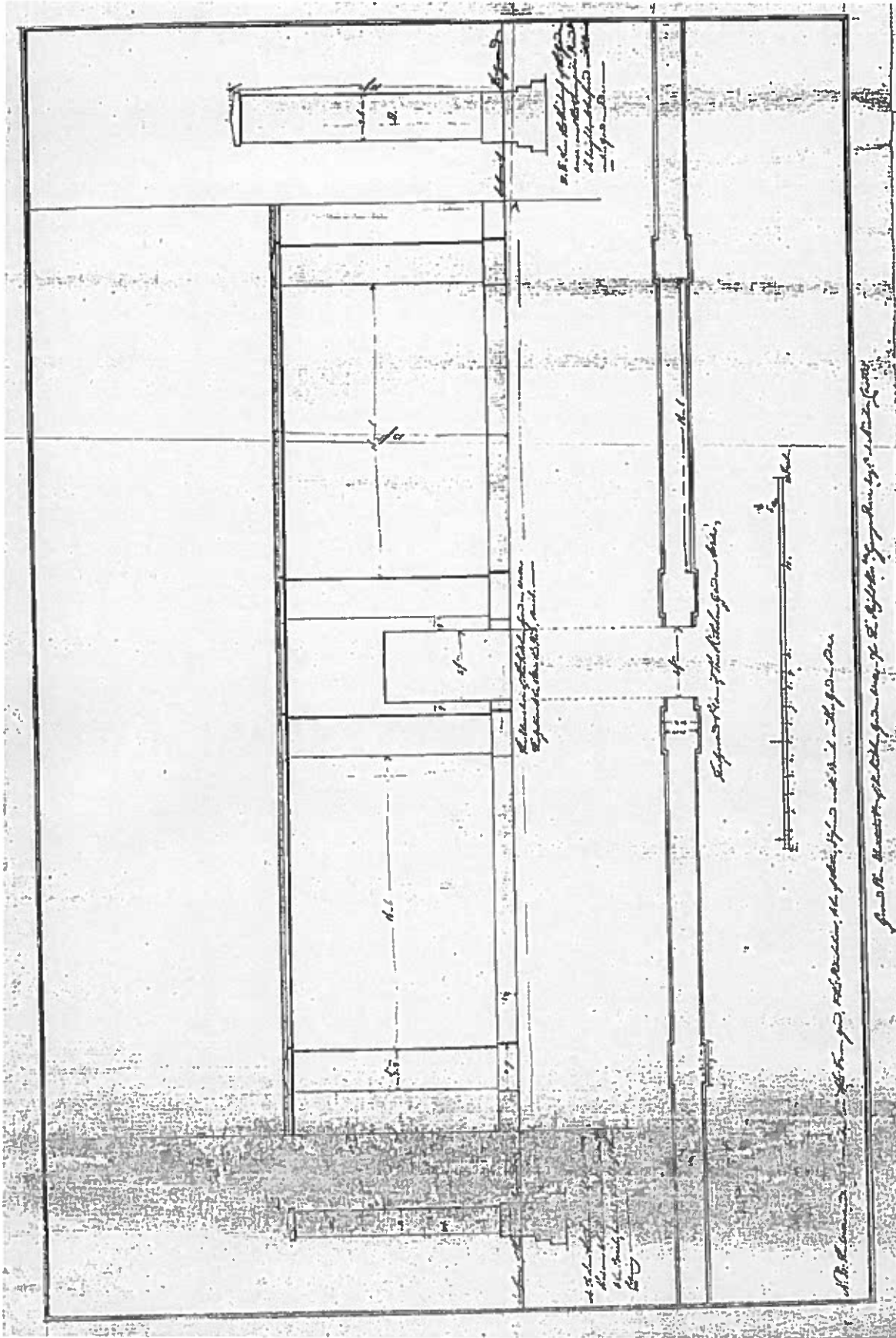

South view of Denefawr Castle 1740

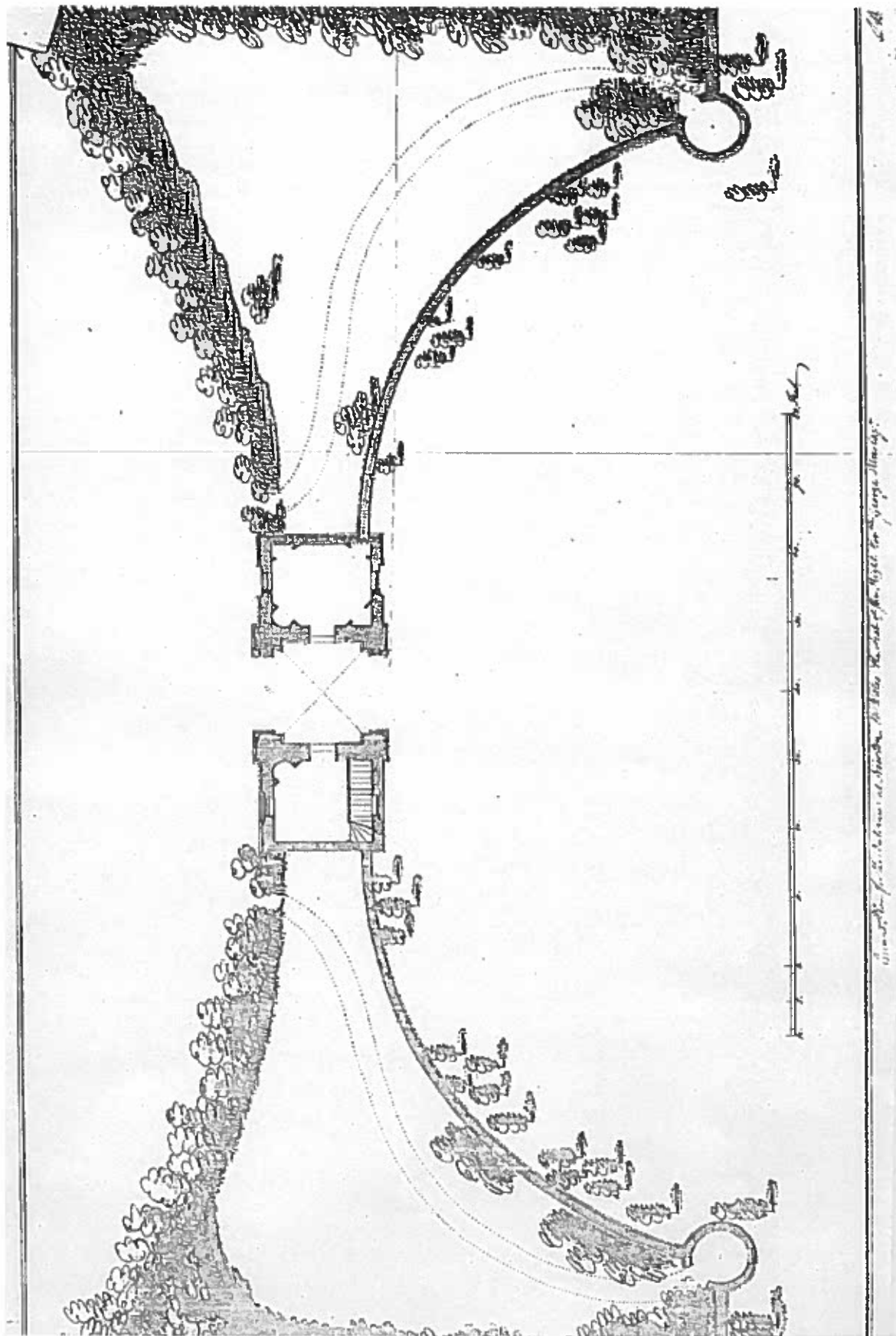


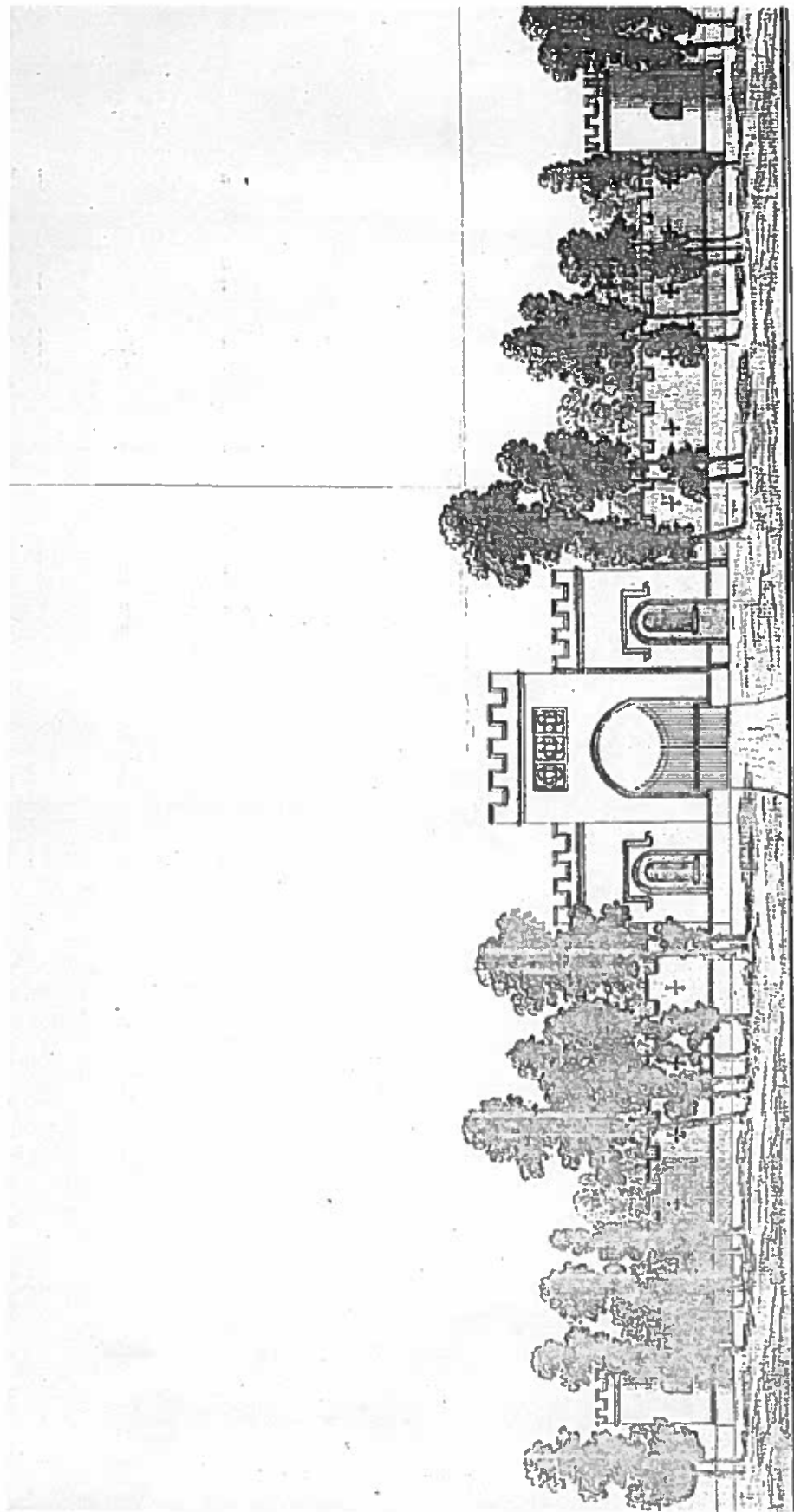

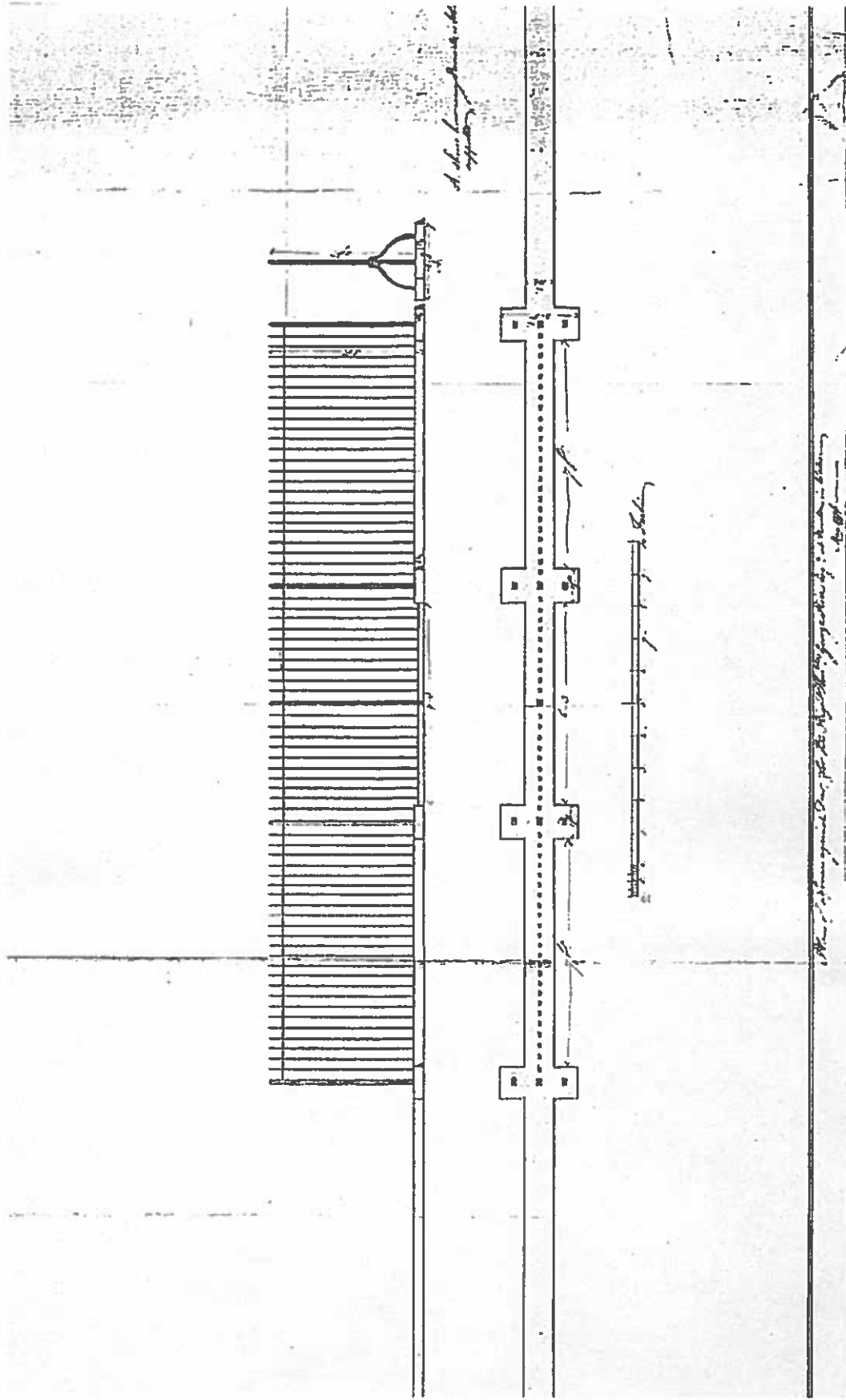


Section of the Entrance Gate - Section on North Side of the Entrance Gate, New York

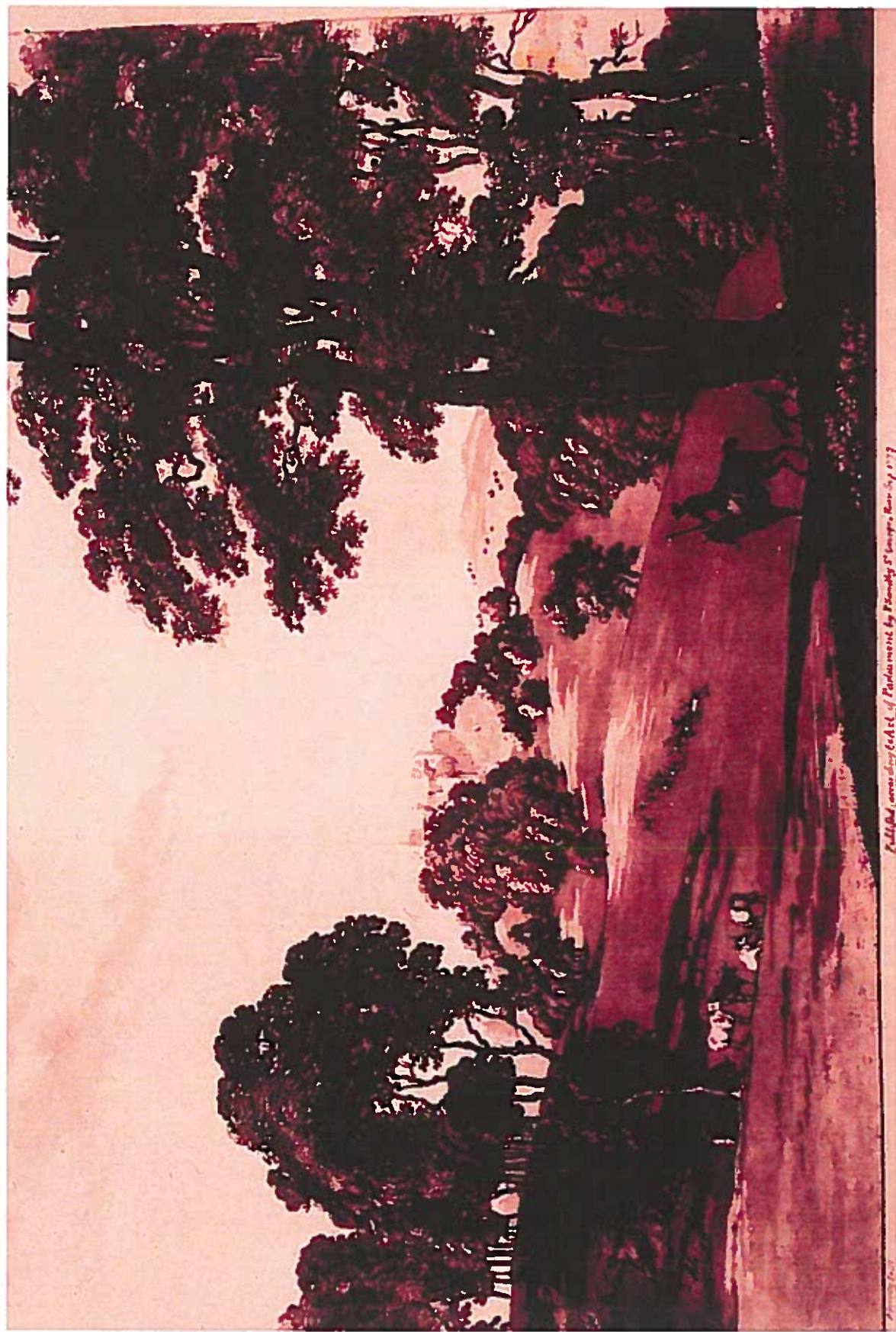

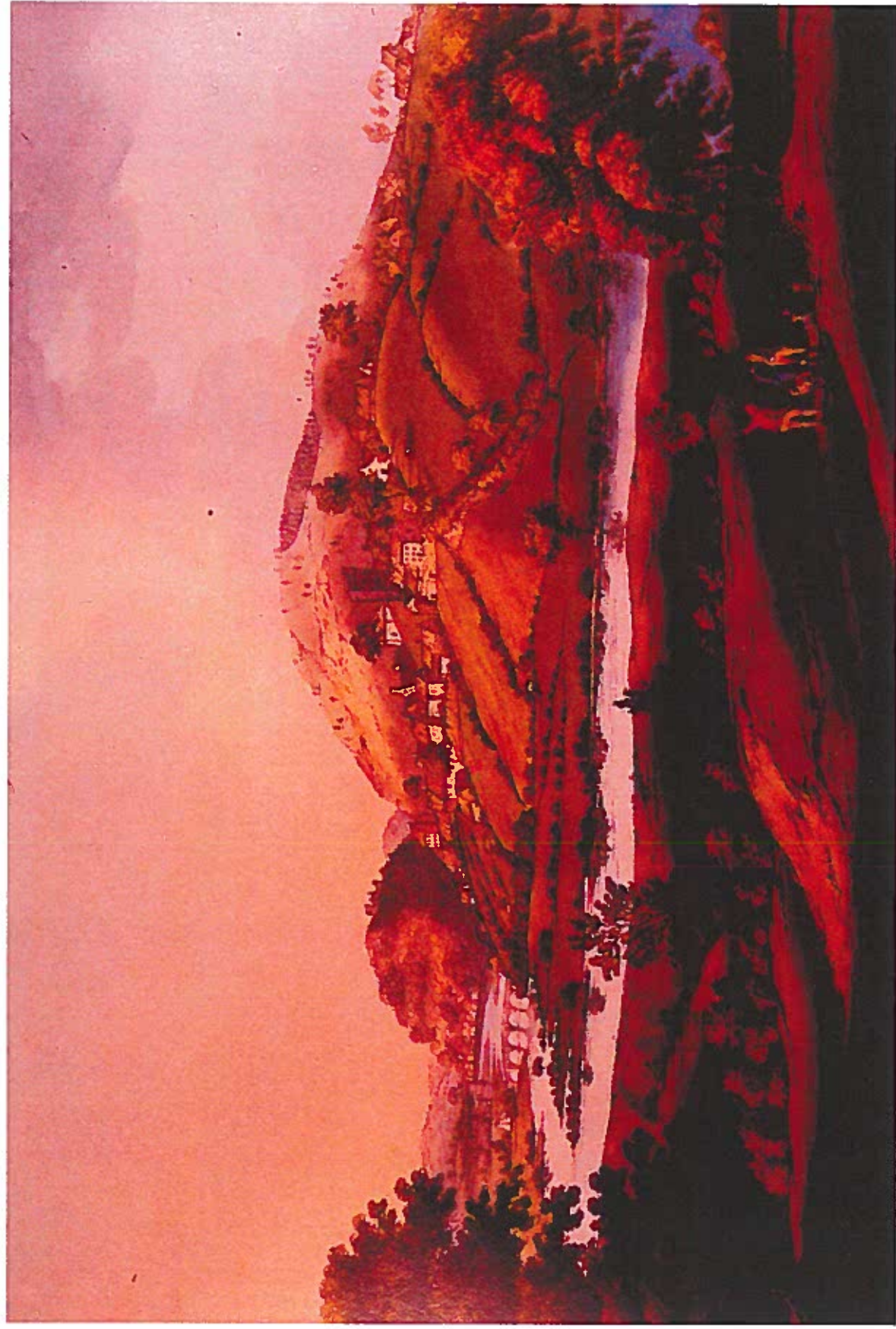

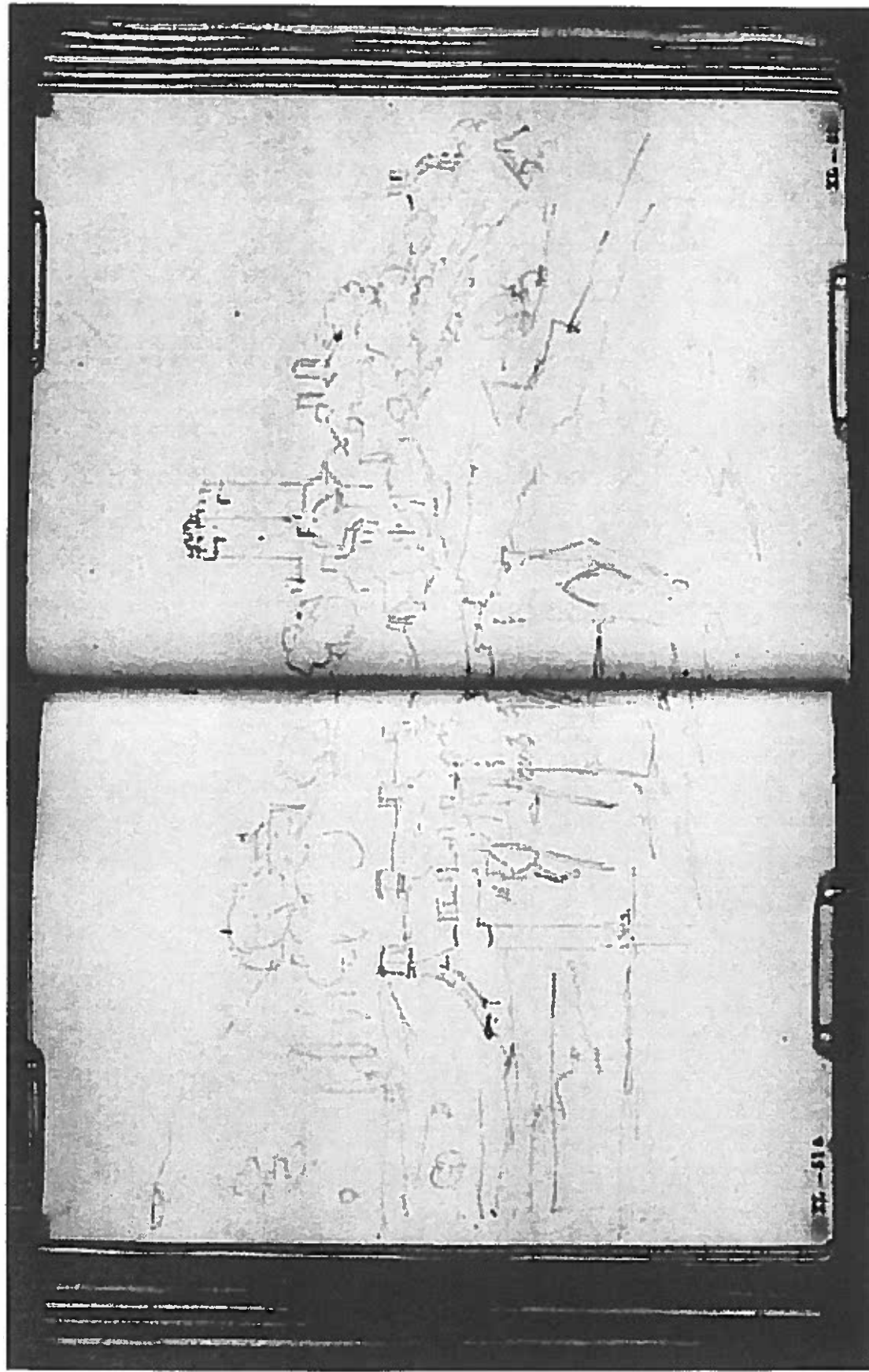

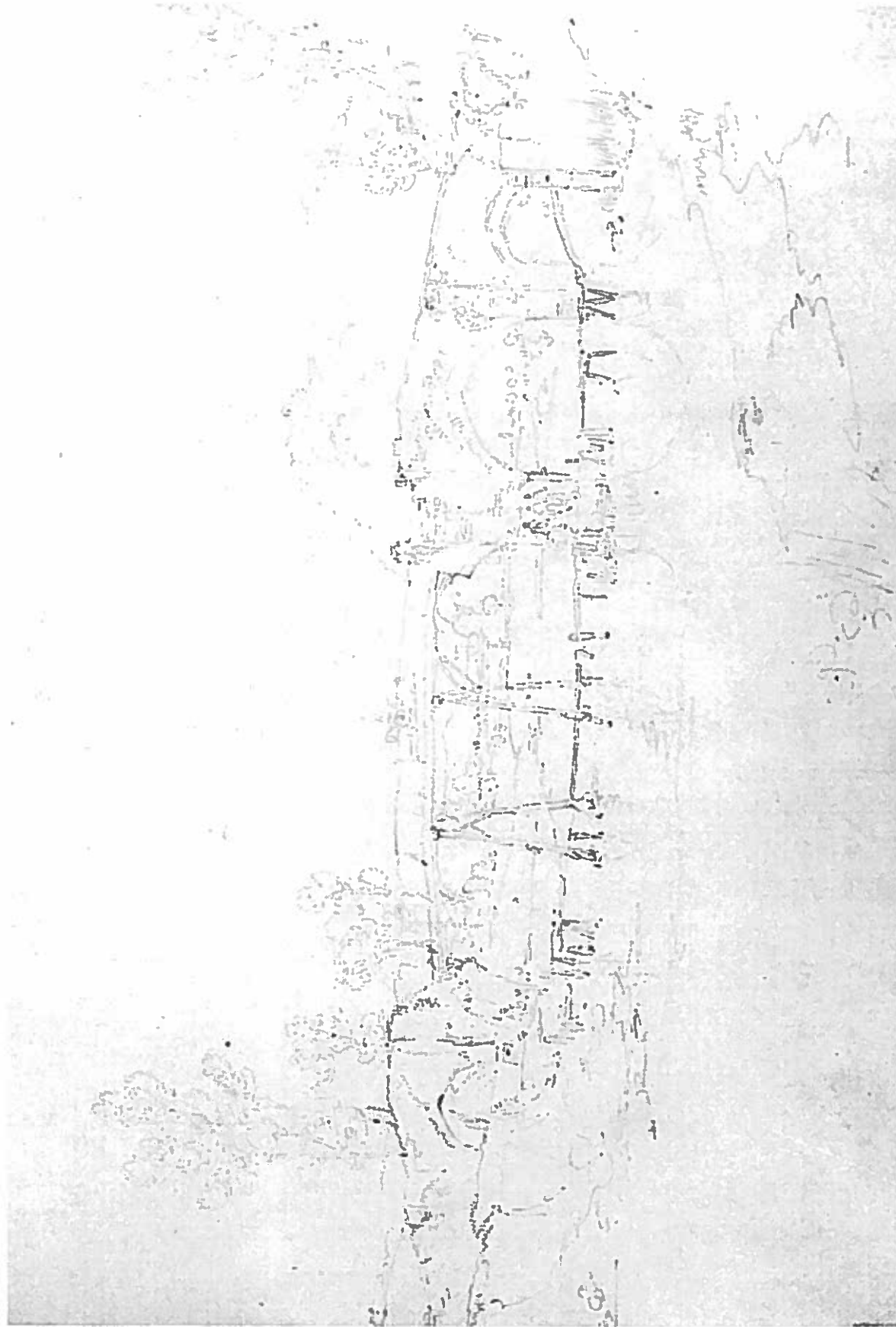

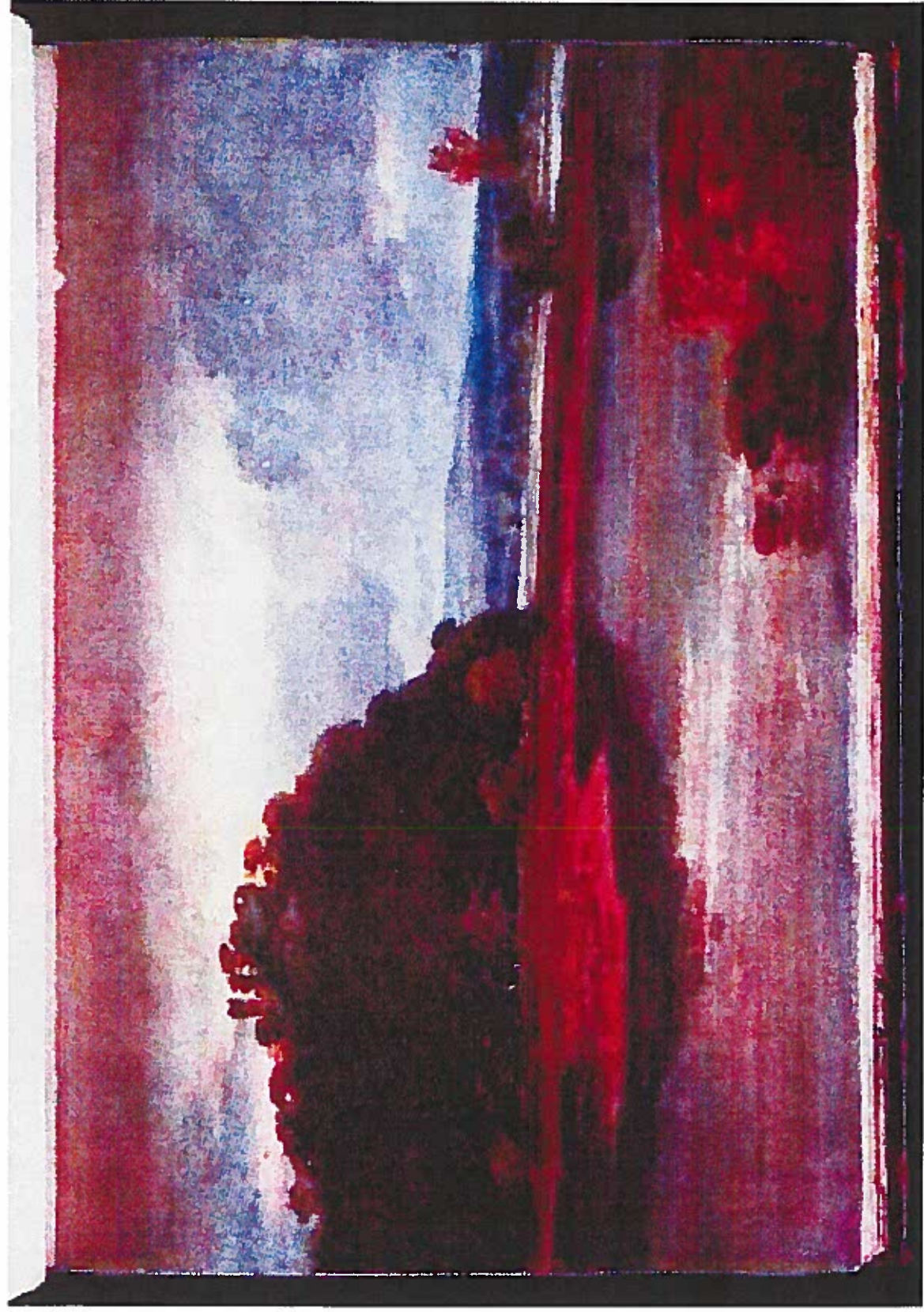

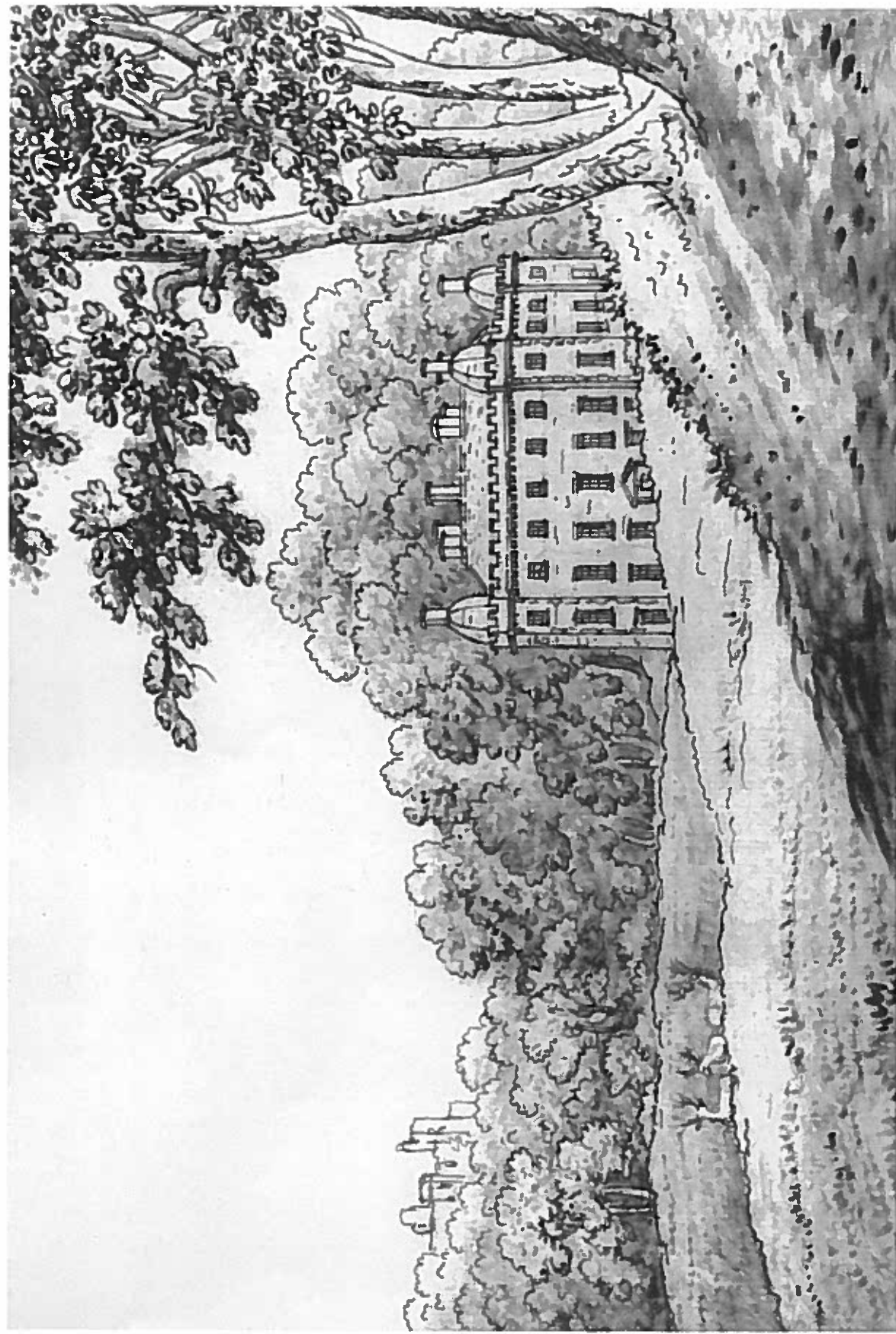

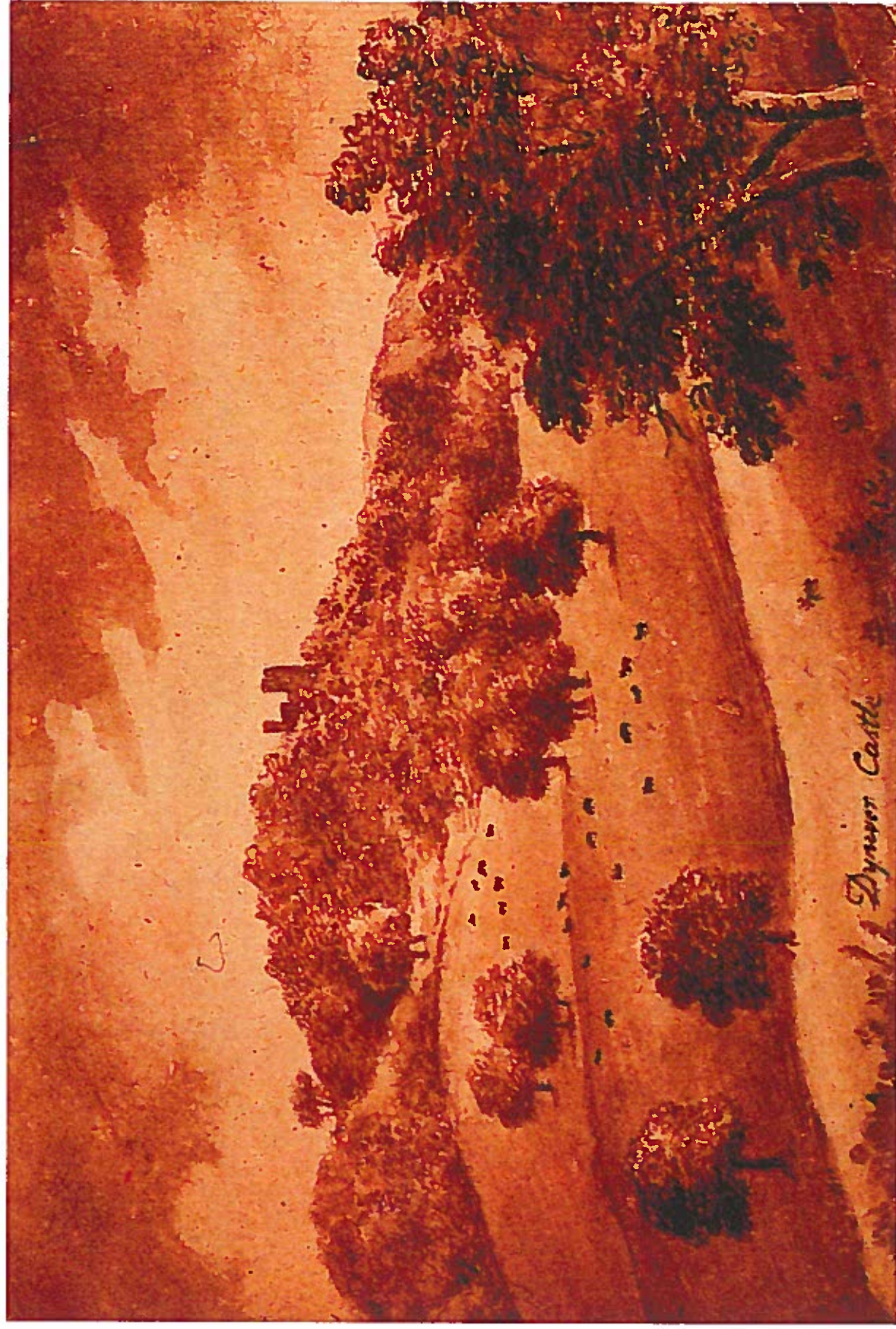

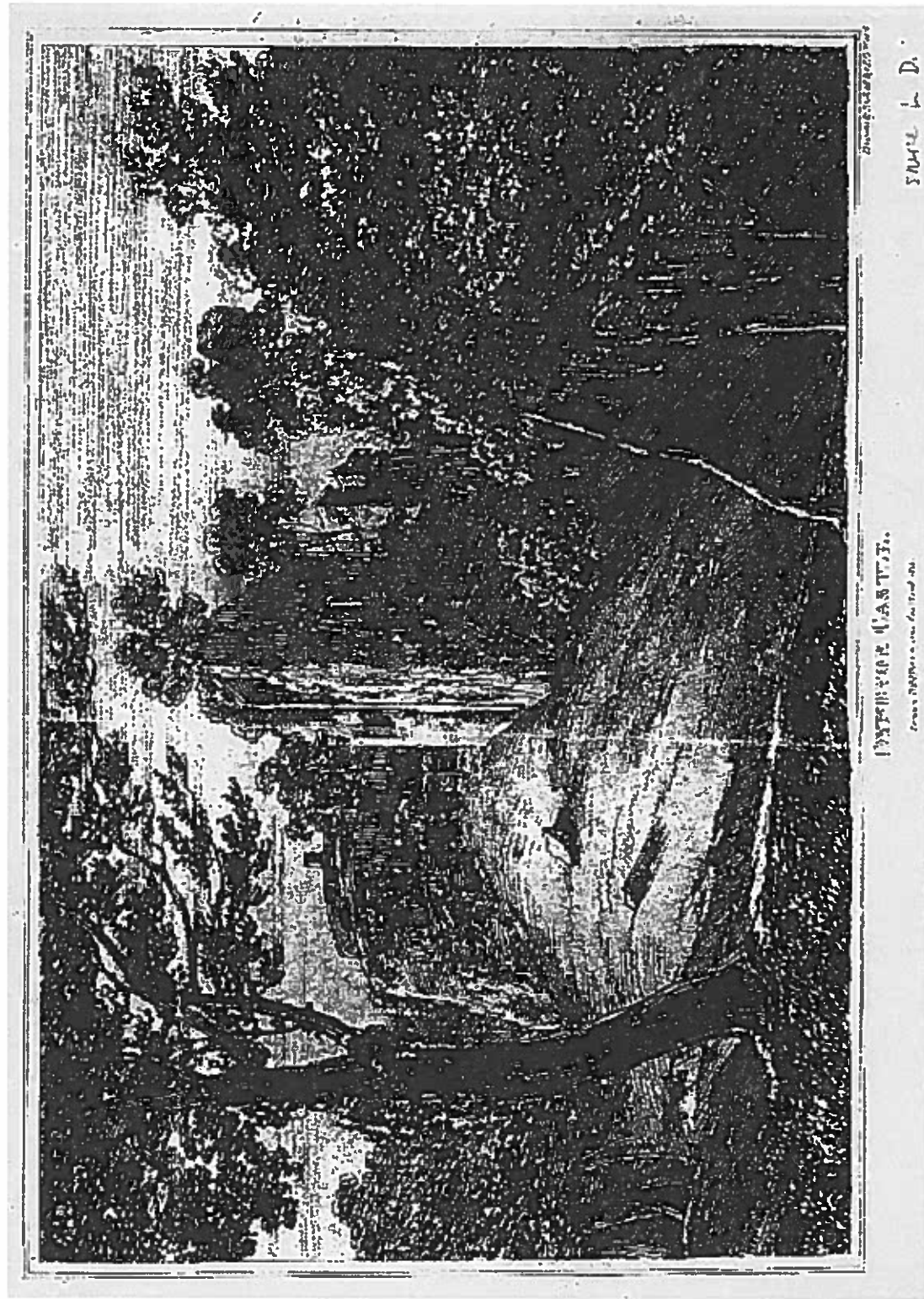

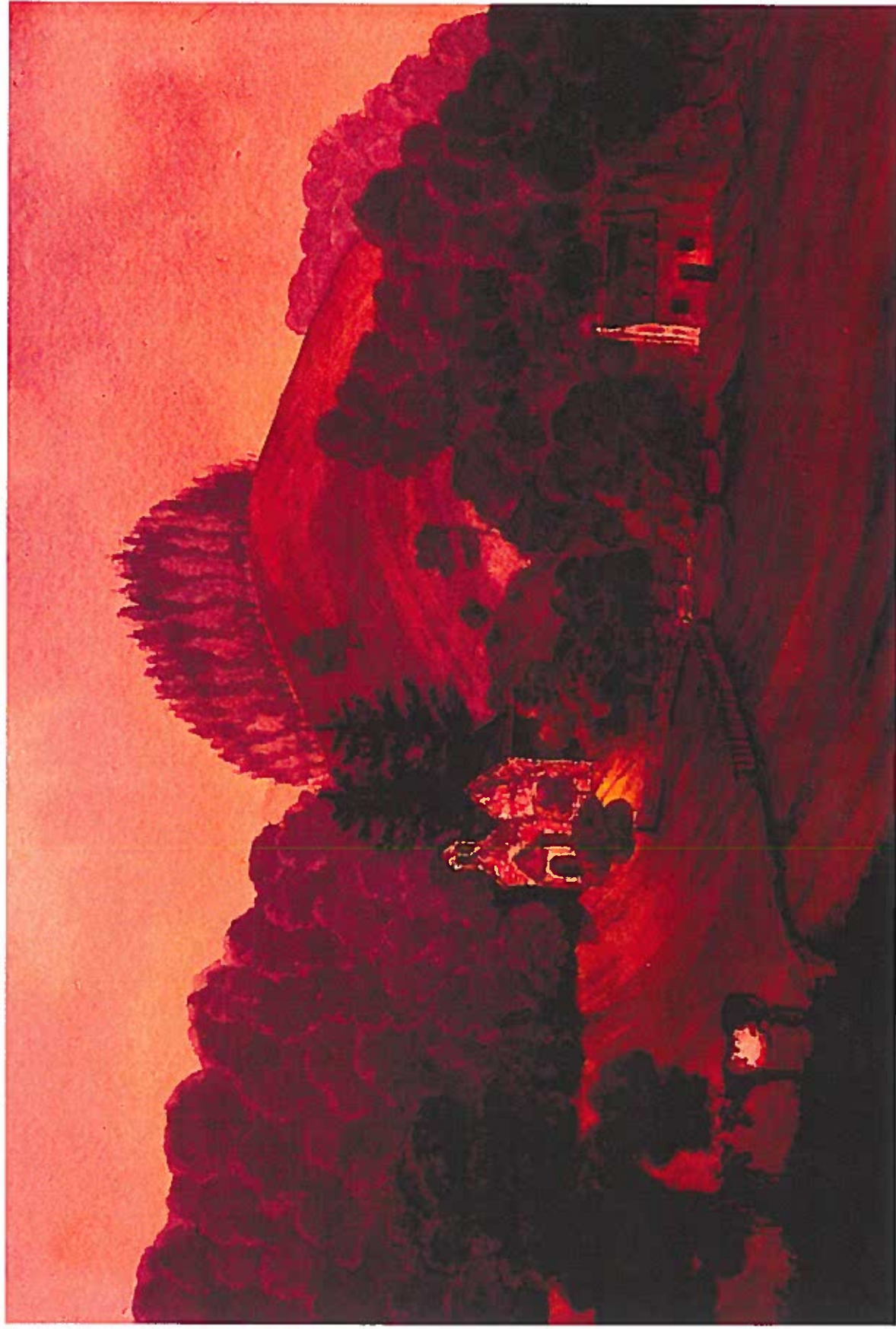

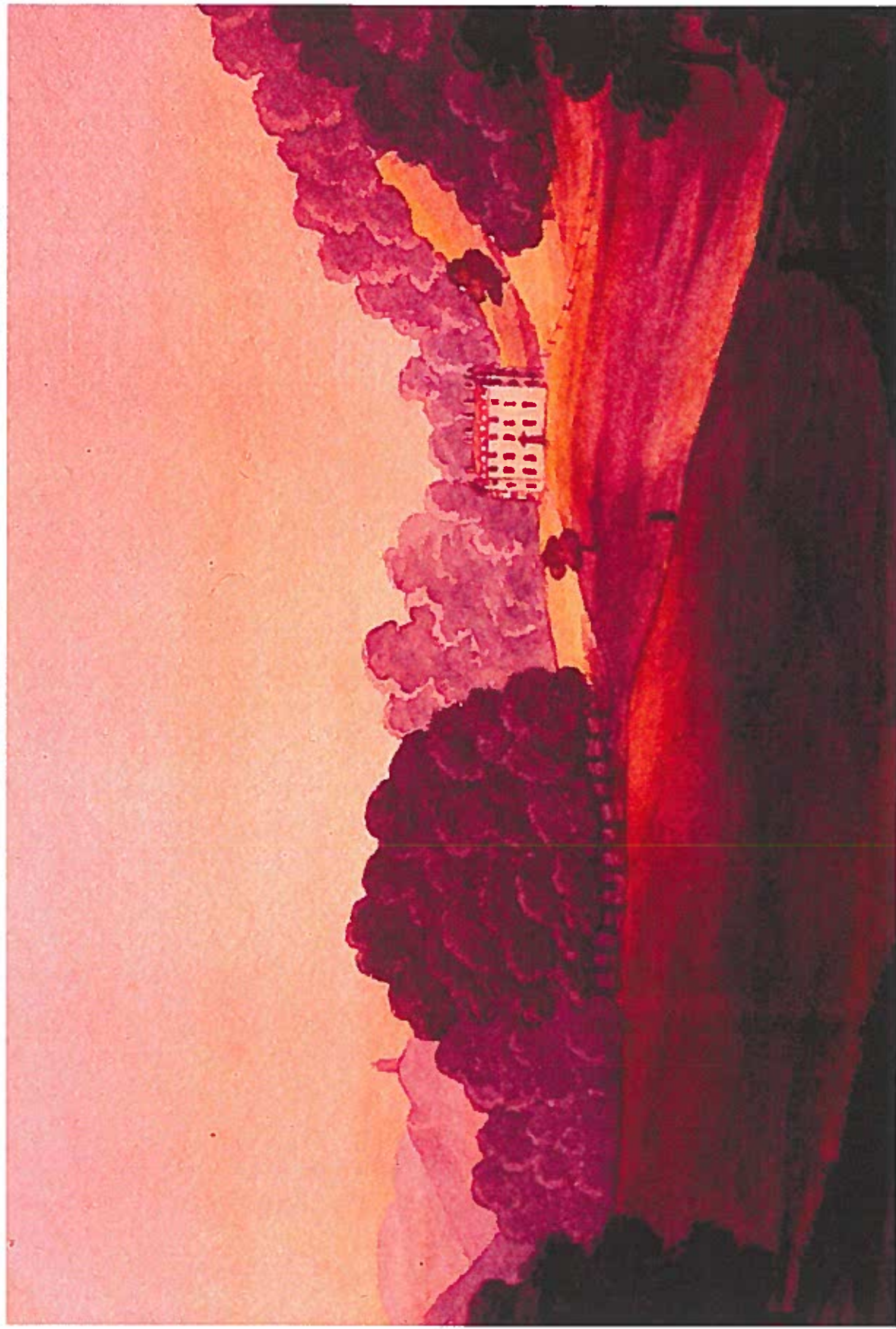

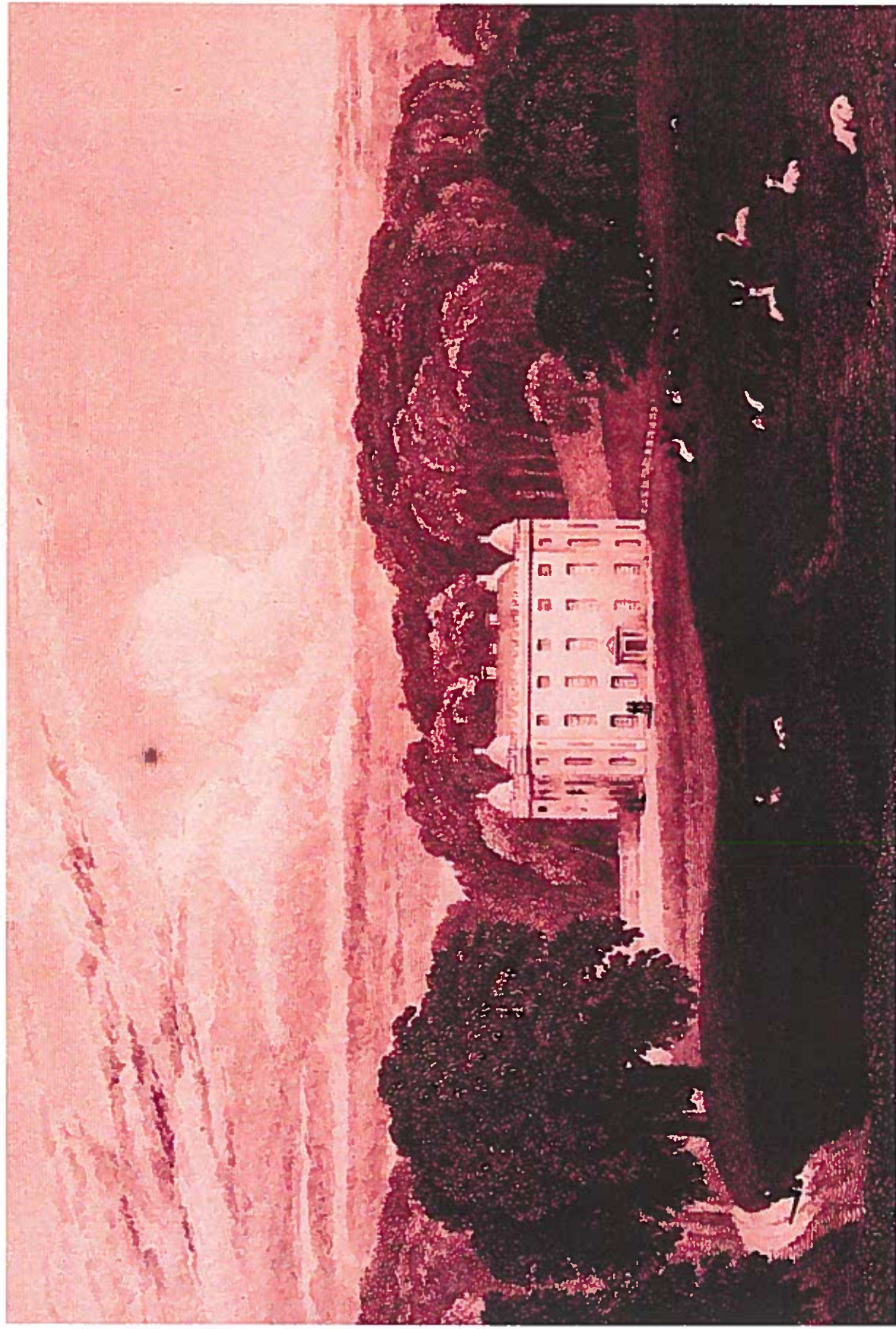

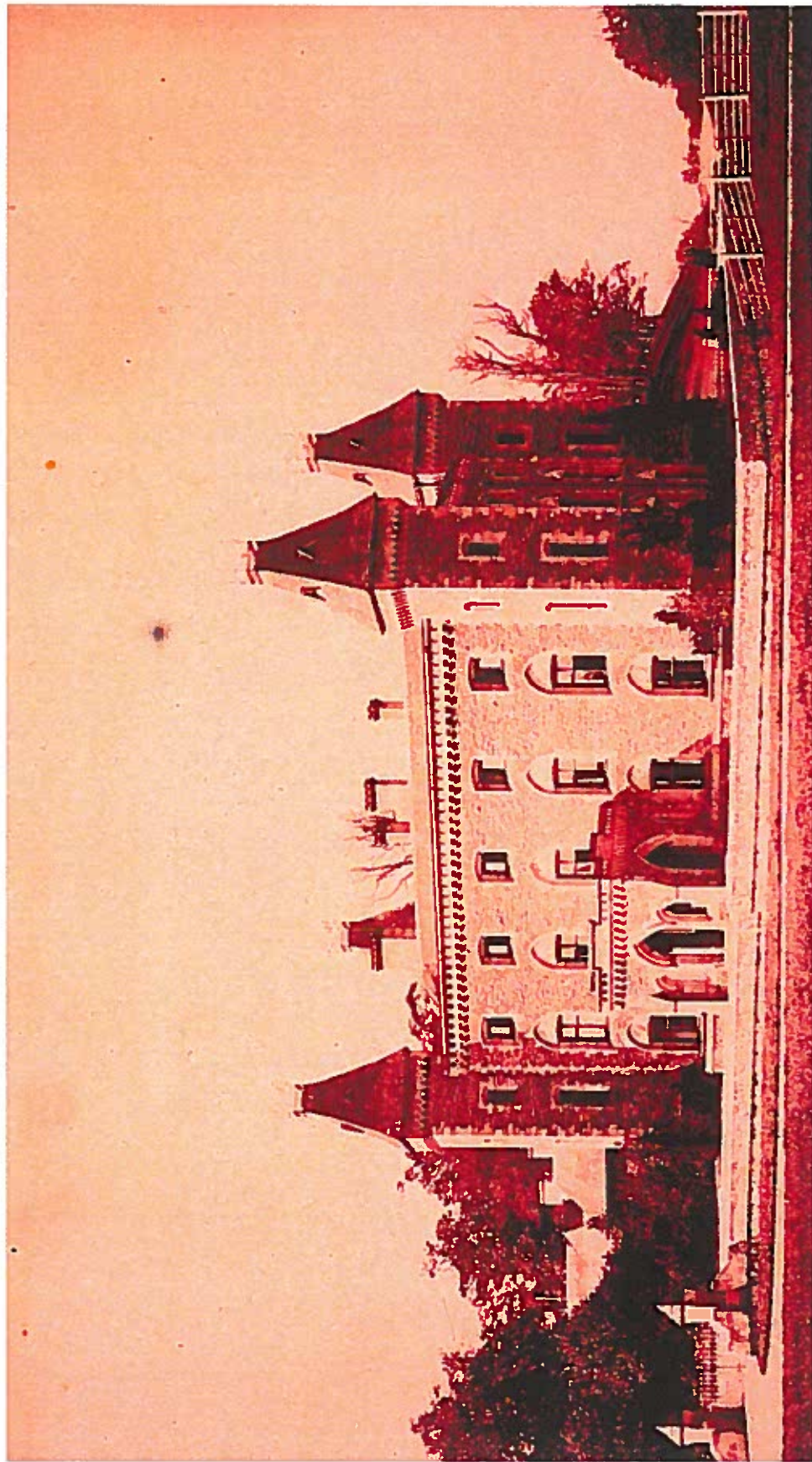

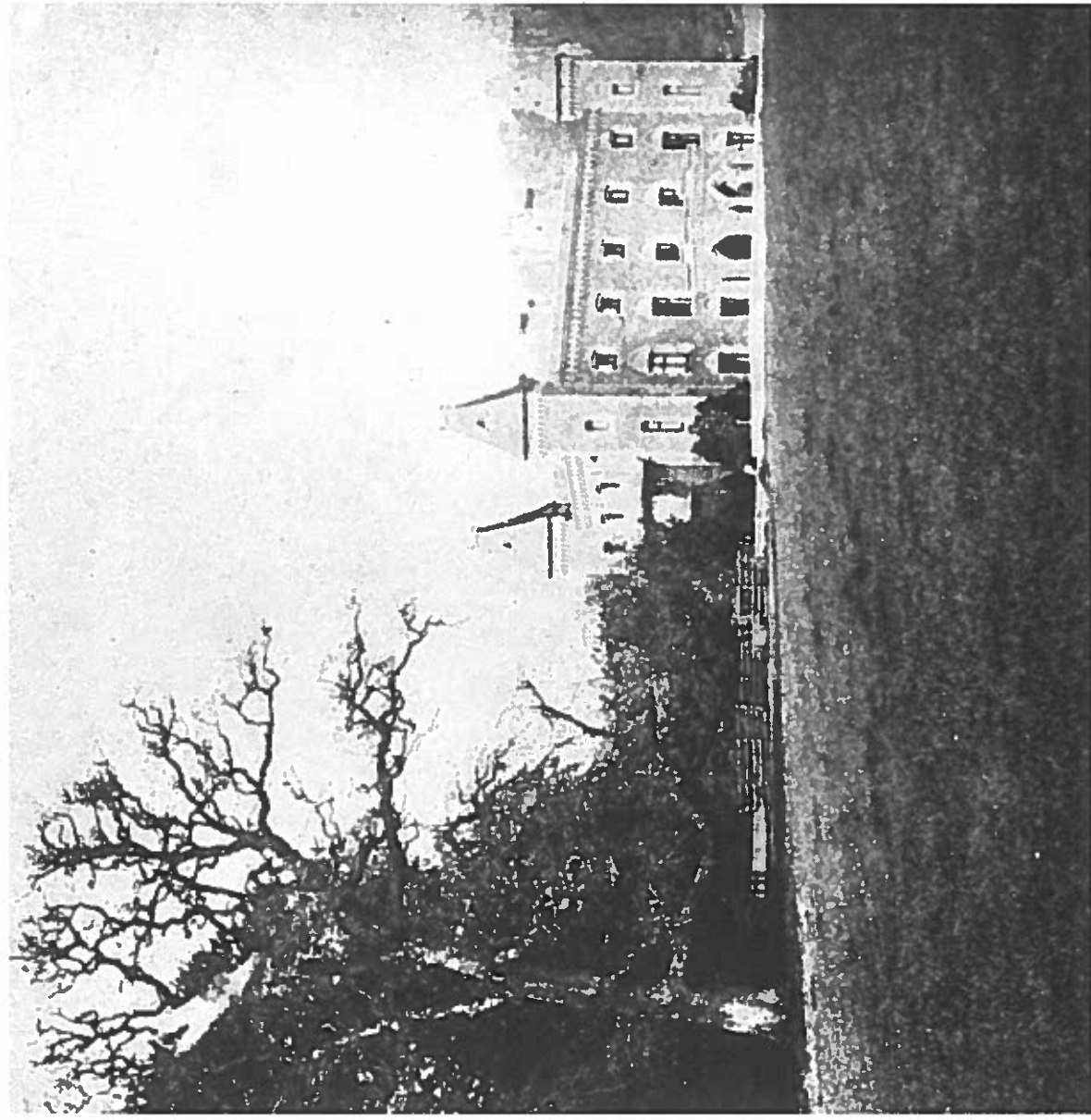

VIEW OF TOWY VALLEY AND DYNFAOR DEER PARK

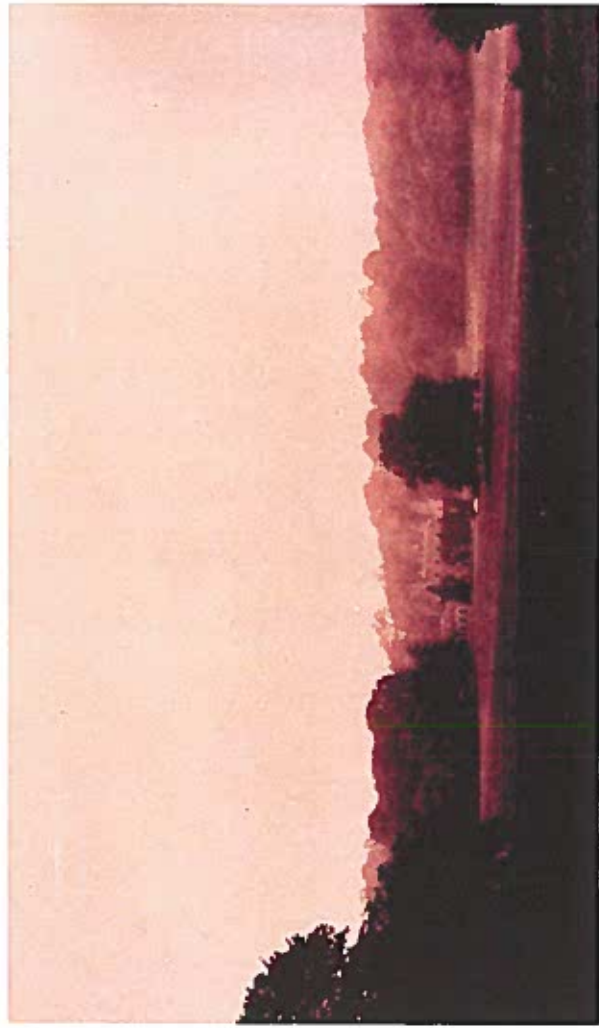

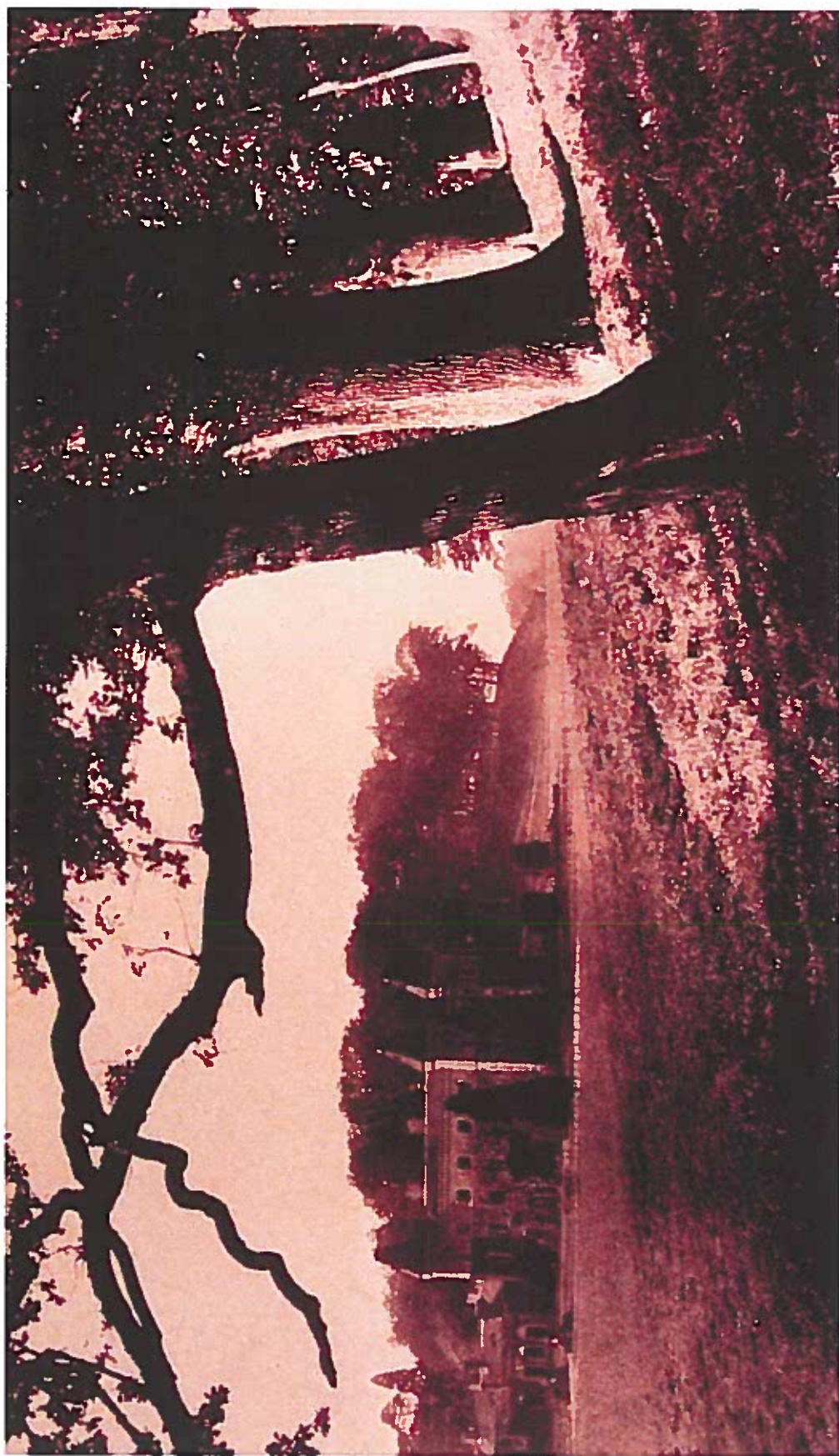

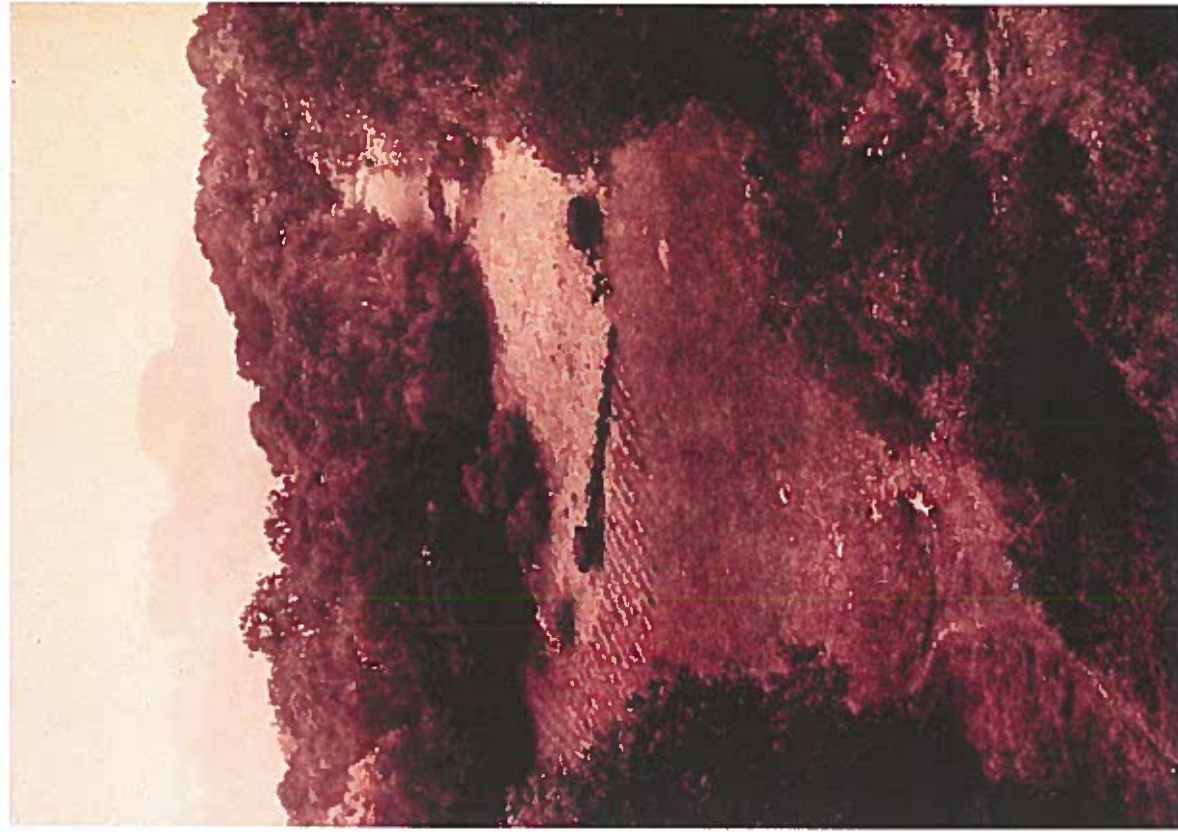

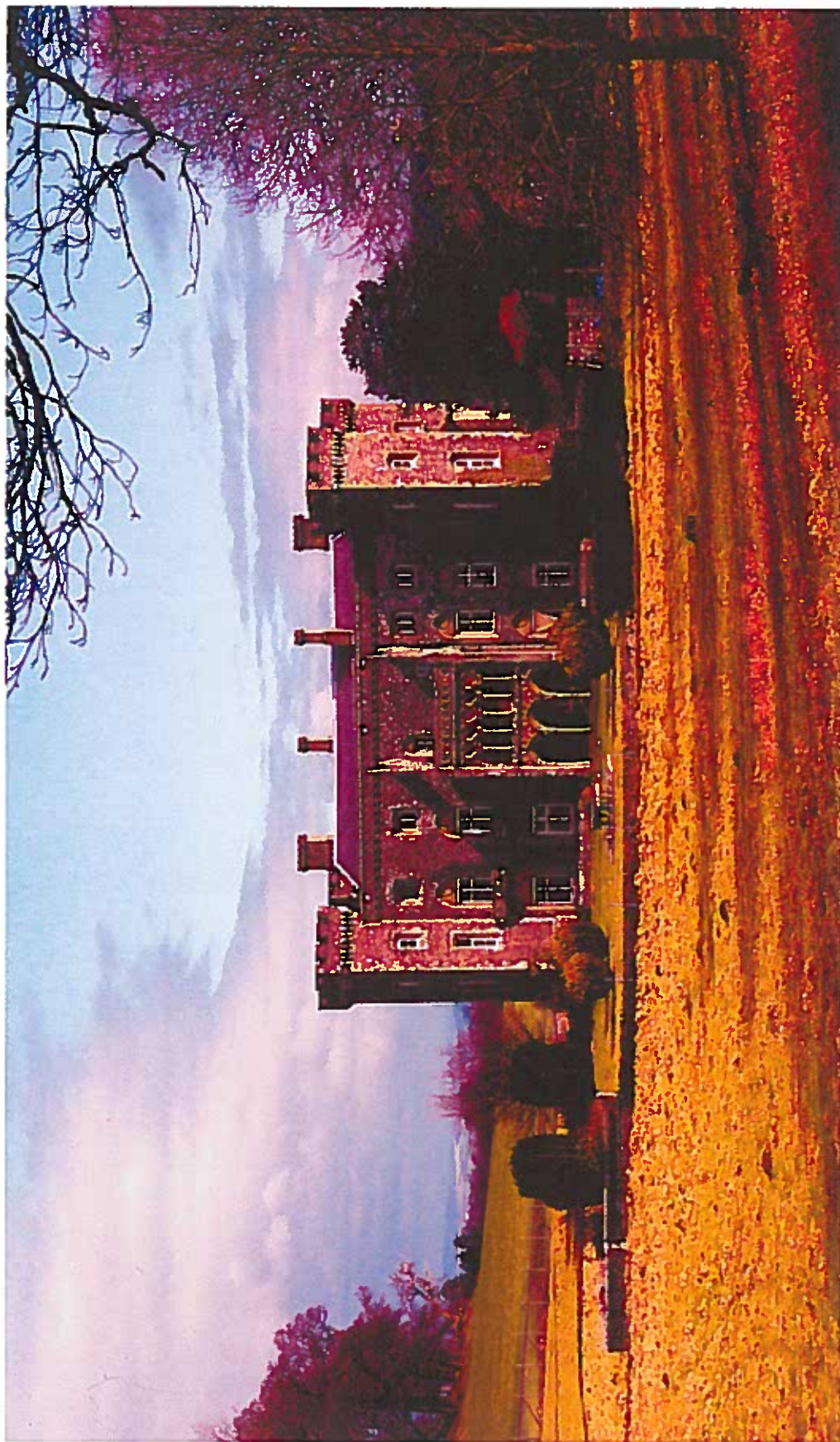

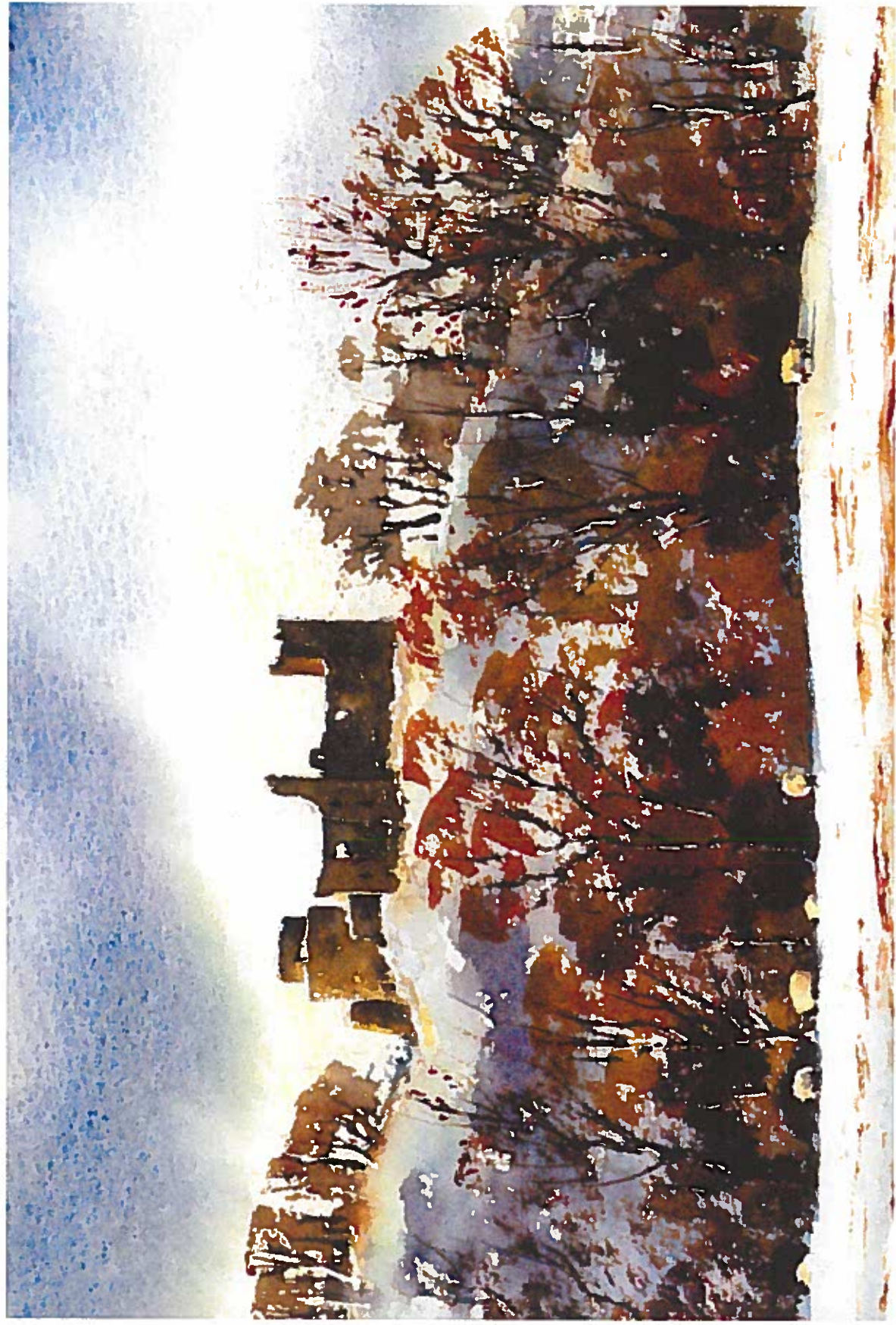
