The stone leans slightly to the WNW (uphill). Well established lichen and moss growth is present. There is a cattle trampled hollow around the base. N Cook PFRS 2004</p> <p>-----</p>



PRN: 48337 Parc Maenhir North – Bronze Age? Post Medieval? Standing Stone/Rubbing Stone SN00667 35860

A well-established (earthfast) standing or possible rubbing stone. It is located on a slight natural ridge on a south facing sloping, pasture field (rectangular), nearer to the southern boundary. The stone stands 1.5m high and is 0.7m wide x 0.6m thick around its base. Thick lichen growth is present on the stone. It is triangular in plan and tapers to a point at the top. N Cook PFRS 2004

In addition to the standing stones identified above, there are records of further prehistoric monuments in the wider landscape, including Neolithic Chambered Tombs (PRNs1424, 1425) and further Standing Stones and a Stone Row (PRNs1444/PE505 Scheduled Monument, 2551/PE1226 Standing Stones Scheduled Monument, 1426 Chambered Tomb/Standing Stone Pair)

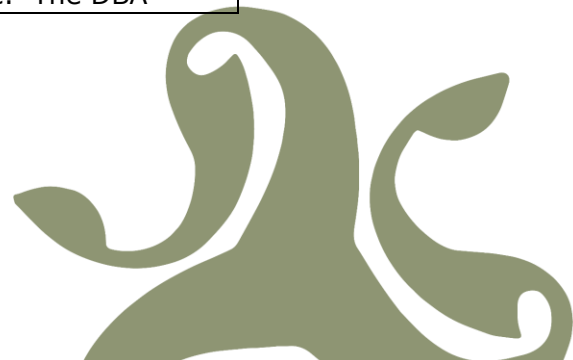
Recommendations:

Due to the proximity of the planting proposals to the Scheduled Monument PE506 Trellwyn Fach Standing Stone, Cadw must be consulted.

The area of the proposed planting is set within a wider landscape of prehistoric funerary and ritual features, and there is a high potential for further unrecorded archaeological remains within the application area.

In addition, the setting of the scheduled and unscheduled historic features needs to be considered.

Therefore, it is advised that a Desk-Based Assessment (DBA) should be undertaken to assess the potential impact of the woodland planting on the archaeological resource. The DBA should include a site walk over survey to identify further visible features, assess potential for further unrecorded archaeological remains and assess the impact of proposals on the setting of the historic features. It also needs to include an assessment of the visibility and intervisibility of monuments in the landscape. The DBA



	<p>should be proportionate and does not need to focus on post medieval landscape development but concentrate on the potential for archaeologically sensitive buried deposits.</p> <p>The DBA should also make recommendations for further archaeological investigation to inform the proposals and advise on possible mitigation. For instance, a geophysical survey may be helpful in determining the presence of buried archaeology.</p> <p>The DBA should be carried out according to a Written Scheme of Investigation (WSI) which is agreed with Heneb Dyfed Heritage Management and Cadw and conforms to the Chartered Institute for Archaeologists (CIfA) Standards and Guidance.</p> <p>Please contact Heneb Dyfed Heritage Management for further information and guidance on next steps.</p>

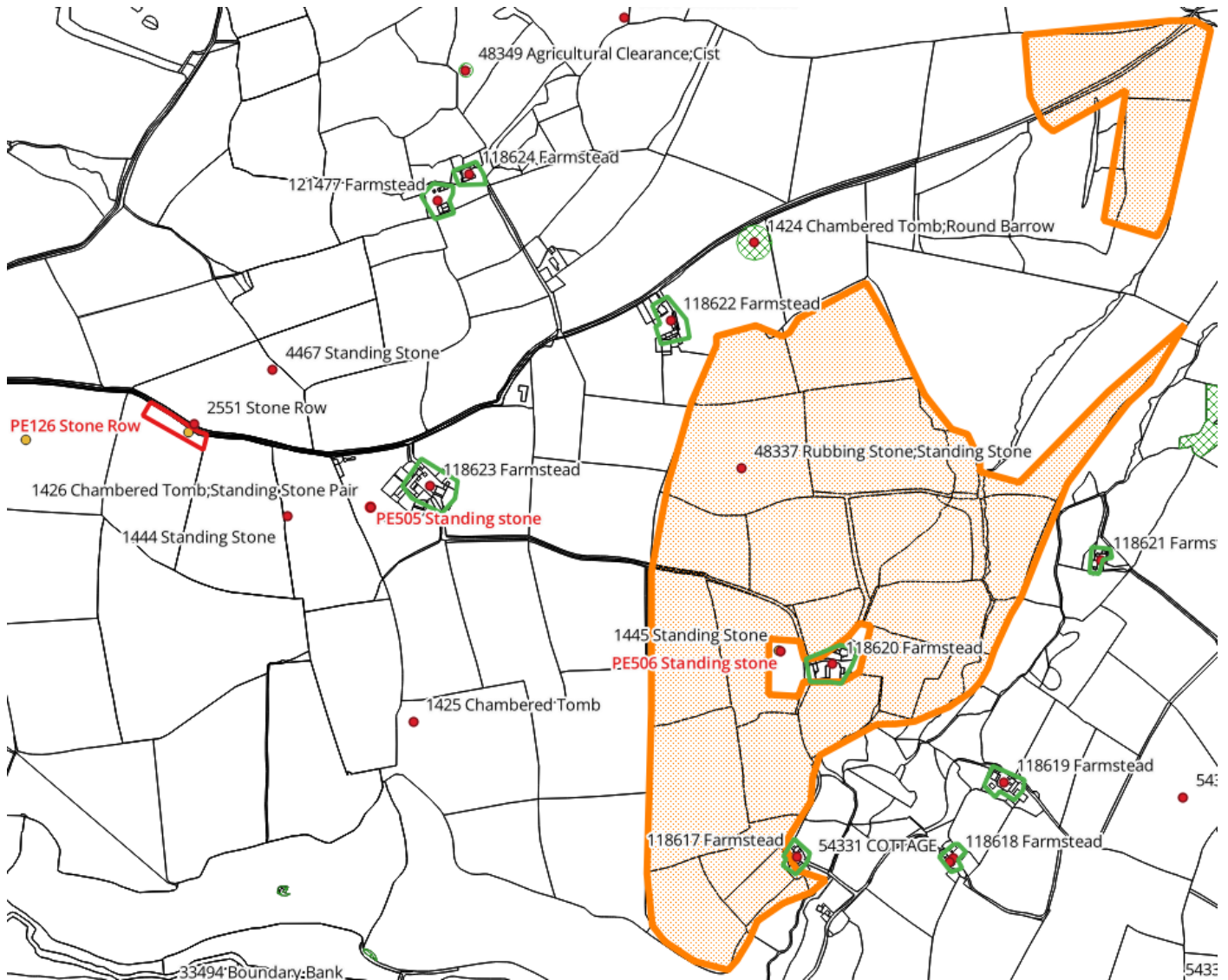
