Thank you for this consultation.

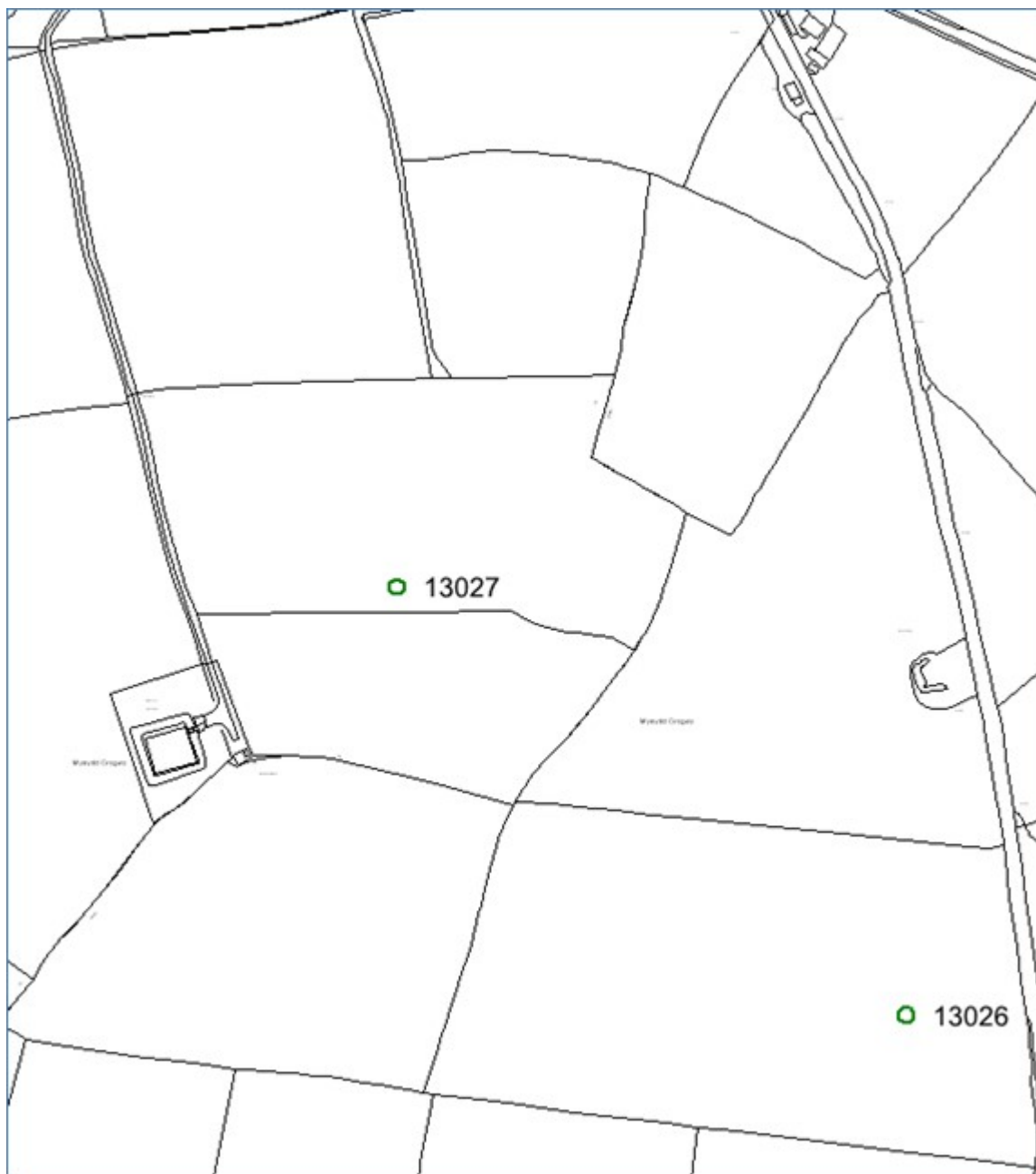
I have checked the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note the following historic environment features recorded within the consultation area;

PRN13026 Standing Stone; Rubbing Stone SN1933039159

There was no sign of a stone at the given grid reference when visited. The field has been recently cultivated for hay. The site has been destroyed and the stone is not marked on modern Ordnance Survey maps. N Cook PFRS 2004

PRN13027 Standing Stone; Boundary Stone SN1900139435

No stone was seen at the given grid reference. The site is now just a pasture field. No stone is marked here on modern Ordnance Survey maps. Site likely to be destroyed. PR 2004 based on NC 2004
