Thank you for your email and for providing the report which is very helpful in explaining what is planned.

I've reviewed the report and photos of the weir as it exists now and can clearly see that although there has been a weir in this location since at least the late 19<sup>th</sup> /early 20<sup>th</sup> century it has been heavily modified subsequently. I recommend that a photographic record is made of weir before, during and after the work is completed, and that these photographs are supplied to the Dyfed Archaeological Trust to be added to the Historic Environment Record (HER). Receipt of this photographic record would fulfil the requirements for NRW to have regard to the statutory guidance; Historic Environment Records in Wales: Compilation and Use. I'm attaching some guidelines for carrying out this work.

Thank you for sending this consultation for the weir on the Afon Dulais at Llanwrda. I've checked the proposals against the Historic Environment Record and note that this weir (PRN 125769) appears on the 1906 Ordnance

Survey map but not on the 1887 (1<sup>st</sup> edition) and appears to have been constructed to supply water power for the Vale of Towy Wool Factory (PRN 21905) which was in operation in the 19<sup>th</sup> century.

Clearly the weir is a historic feature, therefore could you supply more information regarding the proposals for modification? We can then make recommendations as to appropriate mitigation if considered necessary.
