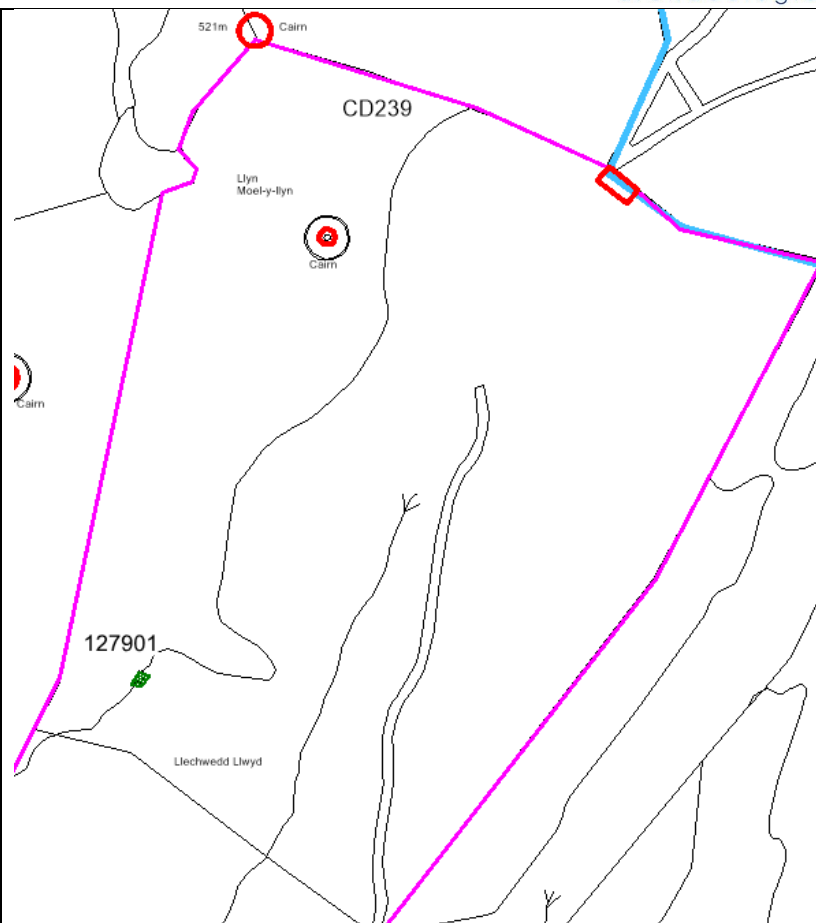

Advice (If the proposal is considered to be inappropriate at this location please provide an explanation)	<p>The following is revised from the site visit on 8th November 2022: Map 1, SN706904:</p> <p>PRN 6265 – Bronze Age Round Barrow (Scheduled Monument CD239) SN71269168 A disturbed but generally well-preserved round barrow cairn, c.19m in diameter and 2.5m high, located on top of Moel y Llyn. NC 2006.</p> <p>PRN 48415 – Bronze Age Round Barrow (Scheduled Monument CD239) SN7155891579 One of a pair of barrows located at the edge of a forestry plantation in a saddle between Moel y Llyn and Banc Bwlchygarreg. Neighbouring barrow 48416 is located 7m away to the SE. This barrow is c.12m in diameter and 1m high and is noticeable for the large number of white quartz stones within its fabric. NC 2006.</p> <p>PRN 55924 – Bronze Age Round Barrow pair (Scheduled Monument CD239) SN7156291575</p>

	<p>Group PRN for the two adjacent round barrows, 48415 and 48416, located 7m apart in a saddle adjacent to a footpath leading onto Llechwedd Llwyd/Moel y Llyn from the Banc Bwlchgarreg forestry plantation. NC 2006</p> <p>PRN 48416 – Bronze Age Round Barrow (Scheduled Monument CD239) SN7156791571 One of a pair of barrows located at the edge of a forestry plantation in a saddle between Moel y Llyn and Banc Bwlchgarreg. Neighbouring barrow 48415 is located 7m away to the NW. This barrow is c.11m in diameter and 1.8m high and appears to be largely intact. NC 2006.</p> <p>PRN 8579 – Bronze Age Round Barrow (Scheduled Monument CD239) SN71329152 A small round barrow cairn, c.6.5m in diameter and 1.2m high, located on top of a the ridge to the east of Moel y Llyn and in close proximity to three other round cairns here, PRNs 6264-6. NC 2006.</p> <p>PRN 126477 – Medieval Dairy SN71339160 Hollow style dairy store recorded at this site of 2x1.8m dimensions</p> <p>PRN 126478 – Medieval Dairy SN71229144 Chamber style dairy store recorded at this site of 4.8x2.6m dimensions</p> <p>PRN127901 – Post Medieval Building SN71179117 A rectangular building is shown, in ruins, on 1946 and 2009 aerial photographs. A Pyper 2022.</p>
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It is understood that tree planting will not be taking place on the upland section of this holding this year, and plans are yet to be drawn up, however when proposals are developed, please refer back to DAT HM for further advice.

PRN 95568 – Post Medieval Lead Level SN70869059

Old level recorded on the 1887 1st edition Ordnance Survey map within the Llechwedd Llwyd lead mine (PRN 25811). Identified as a run in level during the 1993 survey of the site (Protheroe-Jones, 1993, Mine no.12, Site no.10).

This area should be excluded from planting.

PRN 125857 – Post Medieval Sheepfold SN70498989

A sheepfold is recorded on the 1st edition Ordnance Survey map (1887). The sheepfold is roughly square and approximately 9m long though the northeast corner appears slightly canted. A Pyper 2022.

This area should be excluded from planting.

PRN 127846 Post Medieval Mound SN70219015

A small mound is recorded on the 1st edition and 2nd edition Ordnance Survey maps, 1887, 1905. A Pyper 2022.

This was not visible on the site visit and appears to have been levelled.

This area should be excluded from planting.

PRN 127898 Post Medieval Adits? SN77789058

On the south side the river to the Lead Mine (PRN 25811), a number of earthwork gulleys, possible trial adits? When visited this area was covered with bracken so extent taken from aerial photographs. A Pyper Nov 2022.

This area should be excluded from planting.

PRN 127899 Modern Leat SN70249027

A leat is shown on the 2nd edition OS map leading to a wheel pit shown to the north of the buildings at Rhyd Onen farm. The leat survives as a depression and still holds water. A Pyper Nov 2022

This area should be excluded from planting.

PRN 127900 Modern Leat SN70249025

A leat is shown on the 1st edition Ordnance Survey map, 1887, and is a visible earthwork still in 2022. A Pyper 2022

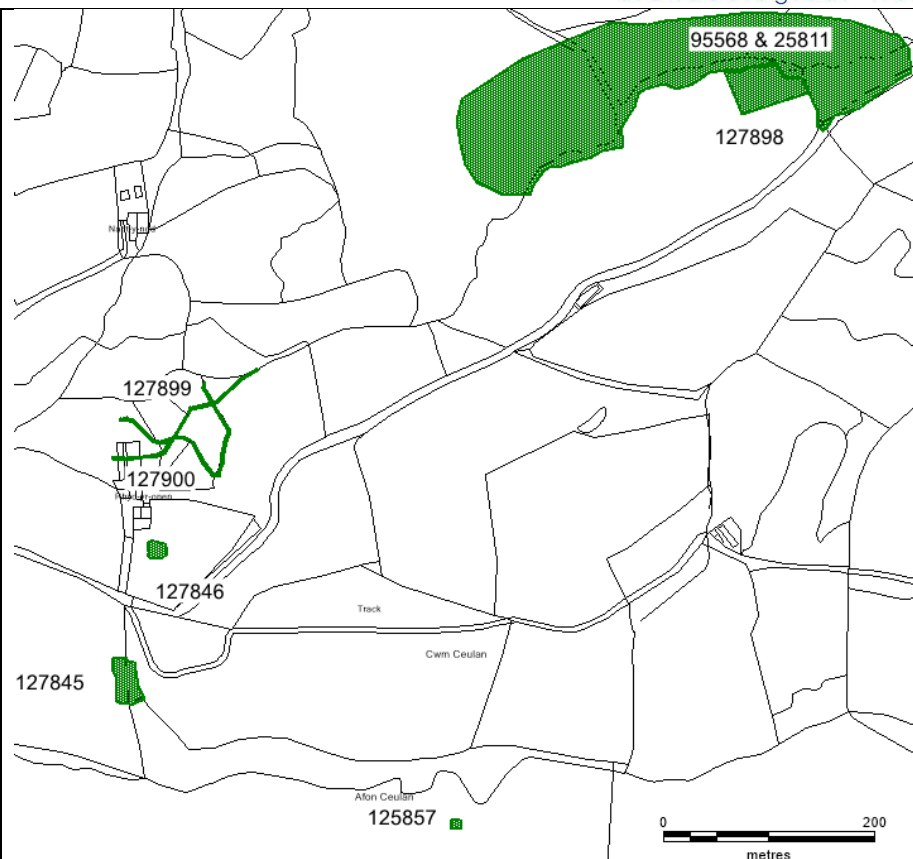
This area should be excluded from planting.



PRN 127845 Post Medieval farmstead SN70189004

A small farmstead including one small building and attached enclosure, is recorded on the 1st and 2nd edition Ordnance Survey map. A Pyper Jan 2022.

This area should be excluded from planting.



Map 2, SN597829:

PRN 121763 Modern Royal Observer Corps Site SN59268333

Royal Observer Corps, Early Warning Post. Site in use from 1940 through until 1959. A Shobbrook.

A brick built aircraft observation post was recorded in 2002 with a protected blast entrance leading to an open topped observation area with an octagonal hole in the roof. A metal column in the floor allowed for mounting an instrument table.

Tree planting must not encroach on the visibility and site lines of this structure.

PRN57741 – Milestone SN4949764895

Listed Building Milestone on A487. Whitewashed stone curved-headed milestone inscribed: 'ABERYSTWYTH 13 miles' the letters of Aberystwyth following curve of head.
