Also I've noted (and this is my omission), in looking again at this that a leat once ran across the parcel which is proposed for planting near the farmstead and also a mound / spoil heap was omitted from my consultation response, see 2nd edition OS map (1906) below (features highlighted in green):

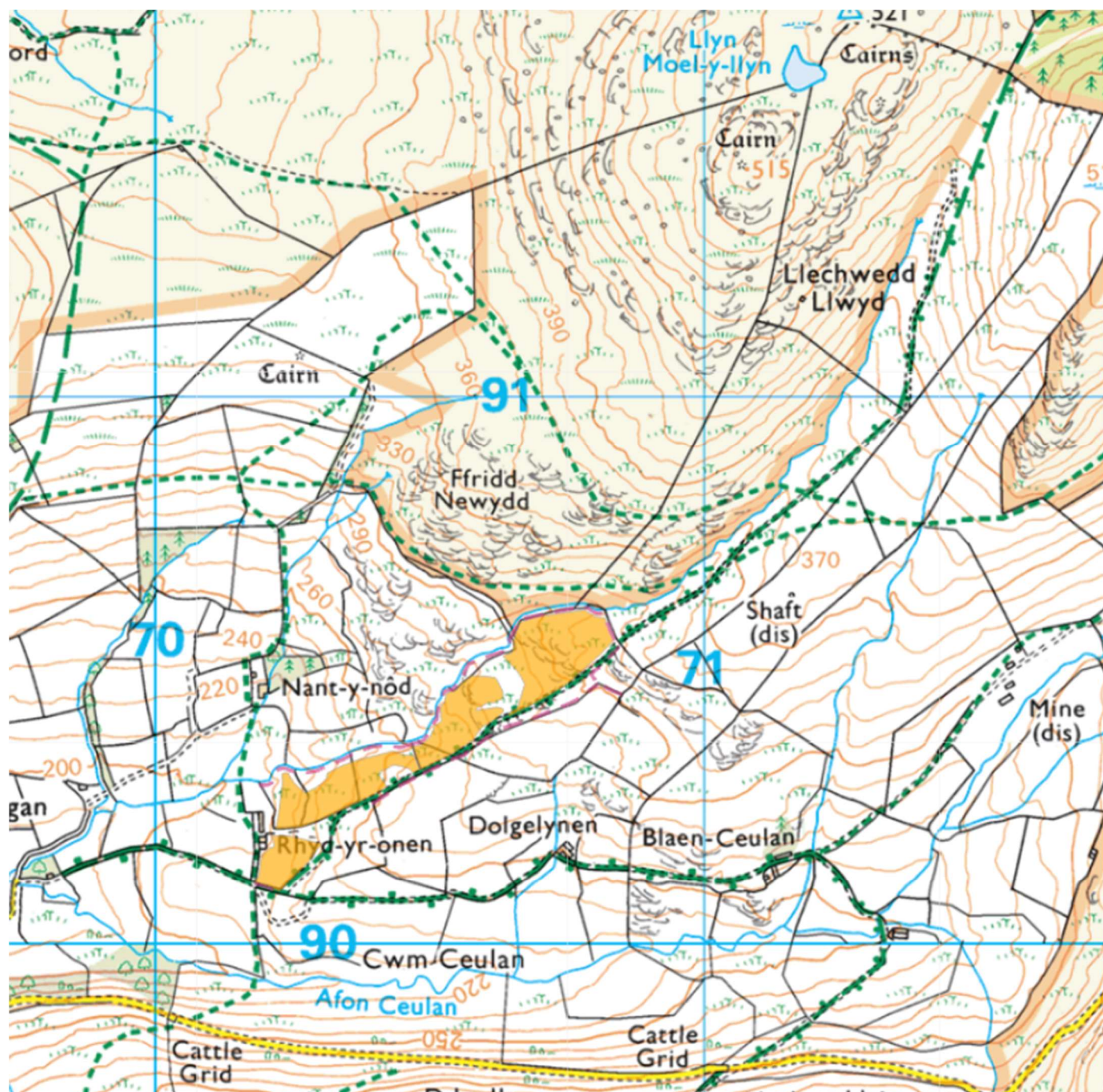
Happy to arrange a visit for Tuesday and ascertain if there are any areas which need to be excluded from planting, and a suitable buffer.

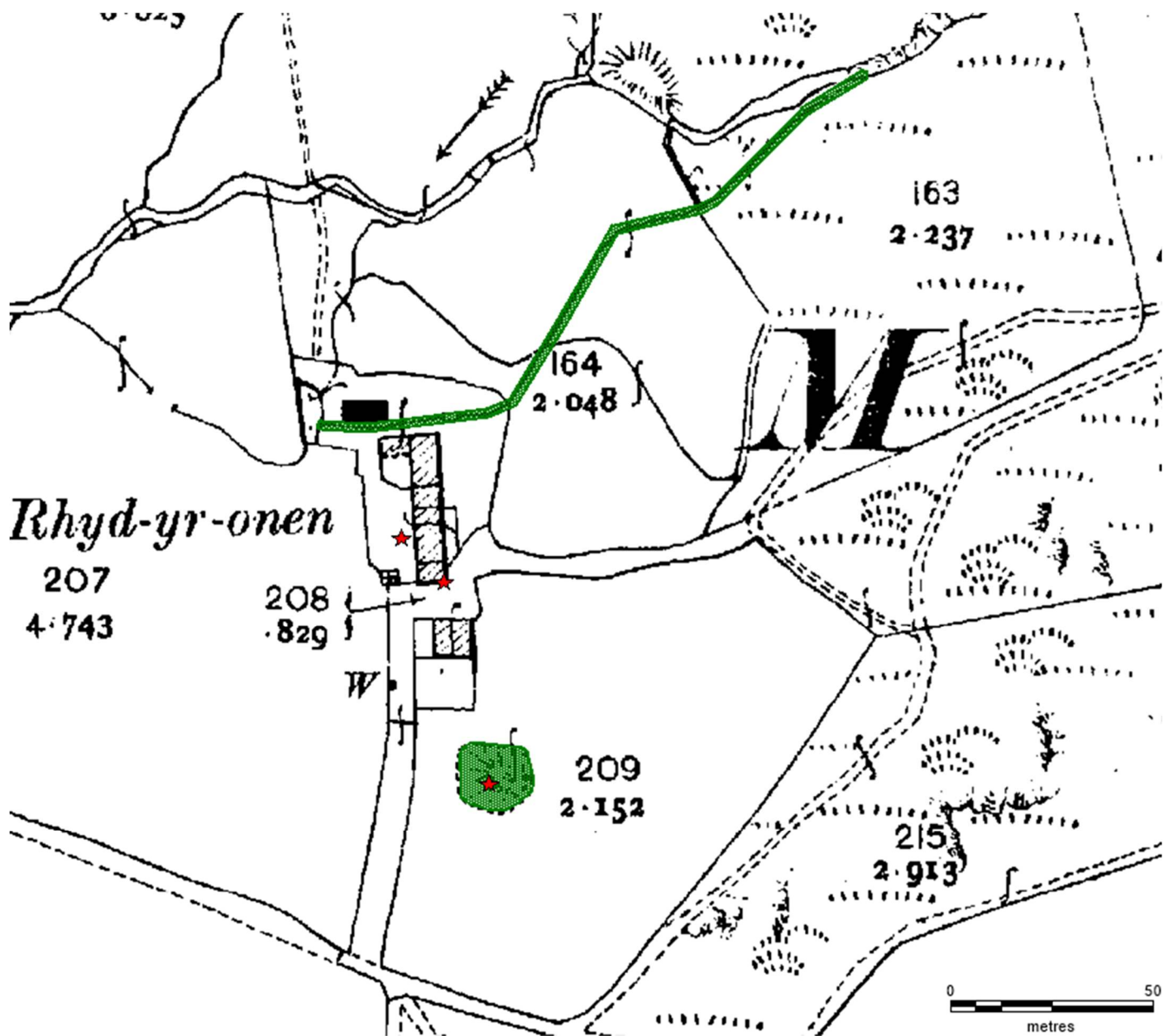
