
Hi Deborah,

Thank you very much for contacting us regarding your proposal for tree planting. The site you refer to is a scheduled monument, an Iron age Hillfort (CD 089, shown in red), and your site lies in close proximity to it. You will need to consult with Cadw about any proposals within 100 metres of the scheduled site. I'm copying in Louise Mees, who is the regional inspector, and who will be able to advise you. Regarding your land beyond the 100 metre buffer of the scheduled site, we have no records of any further archaeological sites, therefore your proposals should not have any detrimental impact, however there is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified you can contact Dyfed Archaeological Trust Heritage Management and further information and advice can be provided as required.

I've attached a pin of where our land is located and another image of our land (in green) and the site in question (in yellow).


