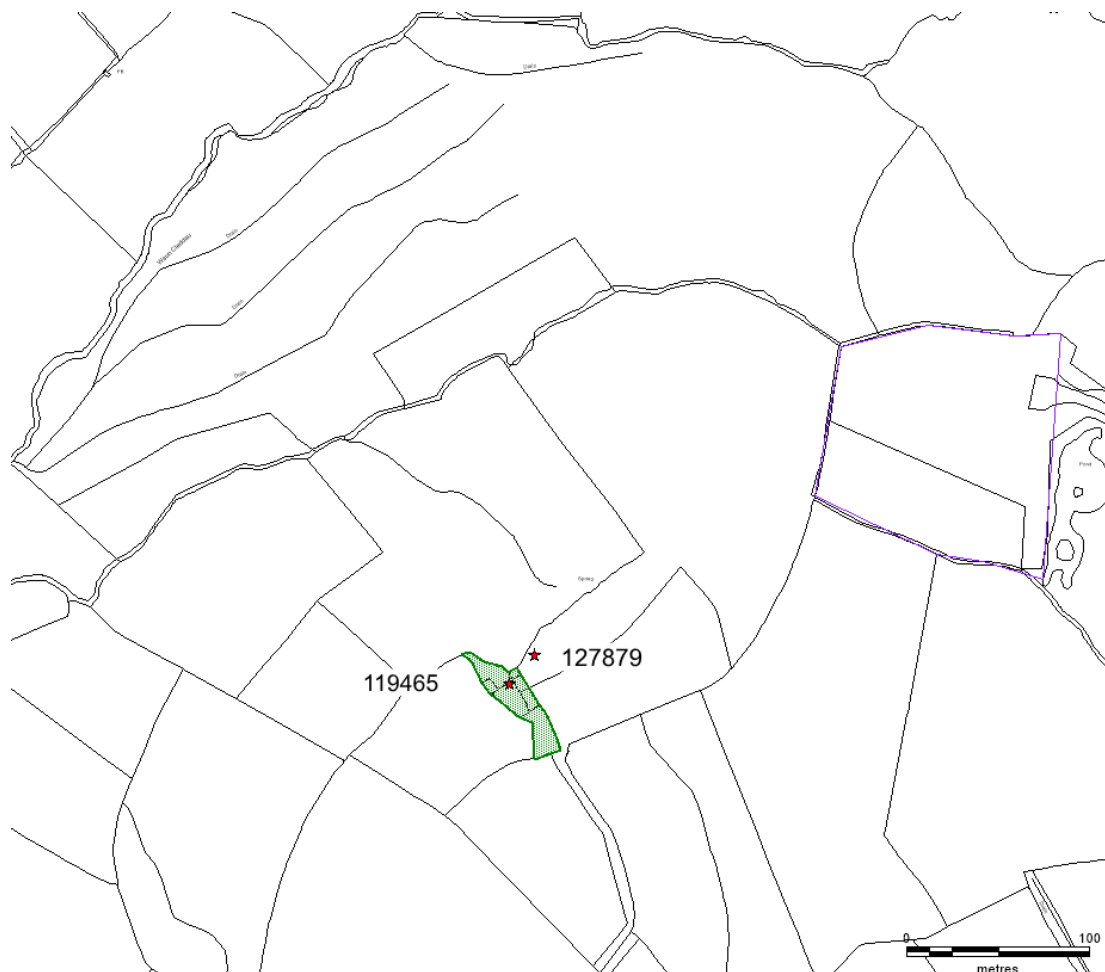
Thank you for your consultation and apologies for the delay. I have reviewed the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note that forestry operations have the potential to impact on the following historic environment features recorded within the consultation area;

PRN 119465 – Portis-Tô Post Medieval Farmstead SN1602531606

The farmstead is recorded on nineteenth century Ordnance Survey maps. It was extant until the mid-twentieth century. By the 1960s it was abandoned and the site of the farmstead and its land planted with conifers. In 2021 it was ruinous, with its stone wall standing up to 2m-3m high. K Murphy 2021

PRN 127879 - Portis-Tô Post Medieval Farm Building SN16033162

A building set away from but probably associated with Portis-to farmstead. Shown on the 1st and 2nd edition Ordnance Survey maps (1889, 1907).

The current condition of these features is unknown; however they may survive as ruins, earthworks or below ground archaeology. Therefore in order to comply with UKFS Forests and the historic environment guidance, DAT advise that these historic environment features (shown in green on the attached map) must be protected from damage during felling operations and subsequent restocking, and tracks and loading areas must not cross these areas.

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified it is important that Dyfed Archaeological Trust Heritage Management is informed and further information and advice can then be provided as required.
