





Thank you for your consultation and apologies for the delay. I have reviewed the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note that forestry operations have the potential to impact on the Historic Parkland Glansevin, shown in green on the map below. The parkland is shown on historic maps as a mix of deciduous and coniferous trees.

Within the historic parkland we recommend that restocking restores a mix of broadleaf and coniferous trees.

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified it is important that Dyfed Archaeological Trust Heritage Management is informed and further information and advice can then be provided as required.
