Dear Paul,

I've had a look at the site in reference to the Historic Environment Record and note the following historic environment features, all derived from historic map sources:

PRN 104643 POST MEDIEVAL COTTAGE SN70301374

The former cottage site of Ynys-dawela recorded on the Ordnance Survey 2nd edition mapping (Carms Sheet 49.03, 1906). Present condition unknown.

PRN 104644 MODERN SHAFT SN70381379

An old coal shaft is record here on the Ordnance Survey 2nd edition mapping (Carms Sheet 49.03, 1906).

PRN 104646 MODERN TINPLATE WORKS SN705137

Glyn-beudy tin plate works and associated railway sidings recorded on the Ordnance Survey 2nd edition mapping (Carms Sheet 49.03, 1906). It is not known what survives of these features today.

PRN 104647 POST MEDIEVAL COTTAGE SN70751388

The former cottage site of Cornel-bach recorded on the Ordnance Survey 2nd edition mapping (Carms Sheet 49.03, 1906). Present condition unknown.

PRN 127880 MODERN COAL WORKINGS SN70141360

Area of disturbed ground shown and spoil tips on the Ordnance Survey map, Carmarthenshire Sheet 49 NE,1953, associated with the old coal mine. A Pyper 2022.

PRN 127883 MODERN TRAMWAY SN70141371

A track or tramway, within a cutting shown on the 2nd edition Ordnance Survey (1906). Thought to be subsequent destroyed by further modern coal workings. A Pyper 2022.

PRN 127885 MODERN COLLIERY SN70431375

An area of disturbed ground around Ynys Amman Colliery, shown on the 3rd edition Ordnance Survey map, sheet 49.NE. A Pyper 2022

These features have been identified from historic map sources - this is shown in green on the map below (I have revised the extent of the features which you had identified on your GIS) however they have not been subject to a site visit therefore their current condition is unknown; they may survive as ruins, earthworks or below ground archaeology, or they may have been completely destroyed by further mining activity carried out in this industrial area.


