Thank you for your consultation and apologies for the delay. I have reviewed the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note that forestry operations have the potential to impact on the following historic environment features recorded within the consultation area;

PRN 127887 Modern Sluice SN65508542

A sluice is recorded on the 2nd edition Ordnance Survey map. Thought to be part of a water management system to supply power to the adjacent Court Grange Lead mine PRN 9135. A Pyper 2022

PRN 127888 Modern Leat SN65478543

A sluice is recorded on the 2nd edition Ordnance Survey map. Thought to be part of a water management system to supply power to the adjacent Court Grange Lead mine PRN 9135 A Pyper 2022

PRN 127889 Modern Leat SN65148570

A leat shown on the 1st edition Ordnance Survey map, which appears to run from Court Grange lead Mine and supplies a wheelpit which is connected to the mine by a Pumping Rod (PRN95699). A Pyper 2022.

The current condition of these features is unknown; however they may survive as ruins, earthworks or below ground archaeology. Therefore in order to comply with UKFS Forests and the historic environment guidance, DAT advise that these historic environment features (shown in green on the attached map) must be protected from damage during felling operations and subsequent restocking, and tracks and loading areas must not cross these areas.

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified it is important that Dyfed Archaeological Trust Heritage Management is informed and further information and advice can then be provided as required.
