Thank you for your consultation and apologies for the delay. I have reviewed the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note that this application lies within the Grade I Registered Park and Garden of Stackpole Court PGW (Dy) 44 (PEM), therefore Cadw must be consulted. I am copying this response to Lisa Fiddes Inspector of Historic Parks and Gardens. In addition I have also noted the following features recorded on the Historic Environment Record:

PRN 46760 Post Medieval Quarry SR97499723  
Quarry, 10m x 5m. Disused, but otherwise in good condition. KM 2003.

PRN 46962 Post Medieval Quarry SR97429721  
20m x 10m old quarry. Disused but otherwise in good condition. KM 2003.

PRN 46963 Post Medieval Boundary Wall SR97439723  
Mortared limestone wall. In poor condition, having collapsed in long sections. Stands to a maximum of 1m. KM 2003.

PRN 46964 Post Medieval Reservoir SR97499729  
20m long, 7m wide and 3m deep concrete tank, probably originally covered with a "Nissan Hut" style structure. Tank survives in good condition, part of brick and stone end wall of hut remain. KM 2003.

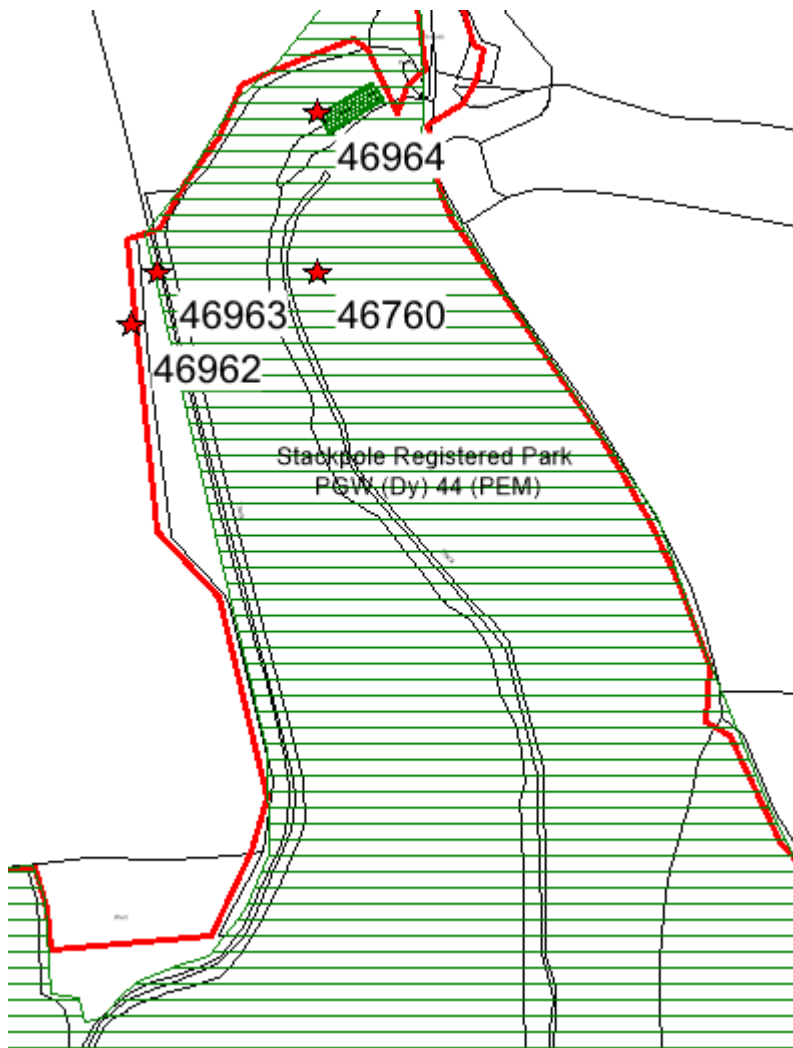

The current condition of these features is unknown; however they may survive as ruins, earthworks or below ground archaeology. Therefore in order to comply with UKFS Forests and the historic environment guidance, DAT advise that these historic environment features (shown in green on the attached map) must be protected from damage during felling operations and subsequent restocking, and tracks and loading areas must not cross these areas.

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified it is important that Dyfed Archaeological Trust Heritage Management is informed and further information and advice can then be provided as required.
