Thank you for your consultation. I have reviewed the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note the following historic environment features recorded within the consultation area;

The site's location is on a gentle west-facing hillslope, just east of Cwmrath farm, at 85m above sea level. In 1965 the Ordnance Survey reported no trace of any antiquity at this location and that according to the farmer there was slag in the field from former coalpits. 

In order to comply with UKFS Forests and the historic environment guidance planting within the areas outlined in green on the map above should be avoided, and access tracks/loading areas should not cross these areas.

In addition the consultation area lies adjacent to the Registered Grade II Historic Park and Garden of Colby Lodge PGW (Dy) 29(PEM). We recommend that any planting adjoining the registered area should be sensitive and avoid having a detrimental visual impact on the registered area. This would be best achieved by a margin of broadleaved species.

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified it is important that Dyfed Archaeological Trust Heritage Management is informed and further information and advice can then be provided as required.
