

We advise that this historic environment feature (labelled on the map above and marked with a green polygon) is protected from damage during forest operations, to comply with UKFS Forests and the historic environment guidance.

The historic maps record this area with deciduous woodland. Therefore, we recommend any restocking be with native broadleaf species.
