NRW Screening Request FLA421 23-24 Well Park wood

Thank you for your felling licence consultation. I have reviewed the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note the application lies within the Registered landscape of Milford Haven Waterway HLW (D) 3 in the Historic Landscape Character Area of Picton and Slebech. https://dyfedarchaeology.org.uk/HLC/milford/area/329.htm

I also note the following features.

PRN40498 PICTON FERRY MEDIEVAL FERRY CROSSING SN01001212 A considerable length of causeway projecting out into the Eastern Cleddau (to allow low water crossings to the quay across at Landshipping?) is shown on the 1854 Admiralty Chart of the River Cleddau. Remains of the upper slipway are visible in the foreshore at the end of the minor road down from Rhos to the crossing point; the former ferry is perpetuated in the name of nearby Ferry Cottages. HJ April 2000.


