

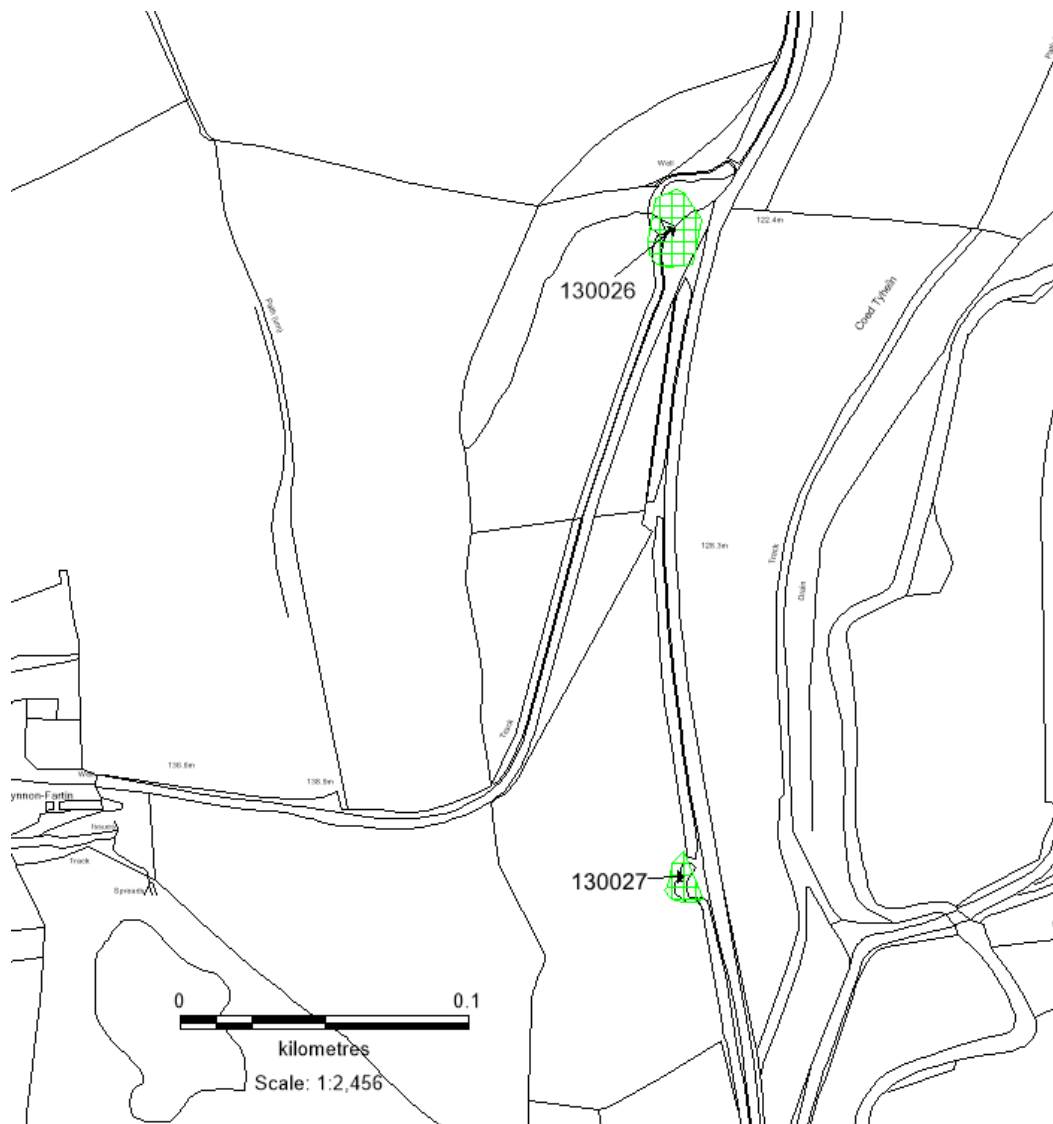

NRW Screening Request Upper Ty Hen Woodland FLA183 23-24.

Thank you for your felling licence consultation. I have reviewed the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note the following features:

PRN130026 COED TYHEN POST MEDIEVAL QUARRY SN3021323855
"Old Quarry" recorded on 1st and 2nd Edition Ordnance Survey Maps. A. Powell 2023.

PRN130027 FELIN-PANDY POST MEDIEVAL QUARRY SN3021623629
Quarry recorded on 1st and 2nd Edition Ordnance Survey Maps. A. Powell 2023.





The current condition of these features is unknown; however, they may survive as ruins, earthworks or below ground archaeology. We advise that these historic environment features (labelled on the map above and marked with green polygons) are protected from damage during forest operations, to comply with UKFS Forests and the historic environment guidance.

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified it is important that Dyfed Archaeological Trust Heritage Management is informed and further advice can then be provided.
