

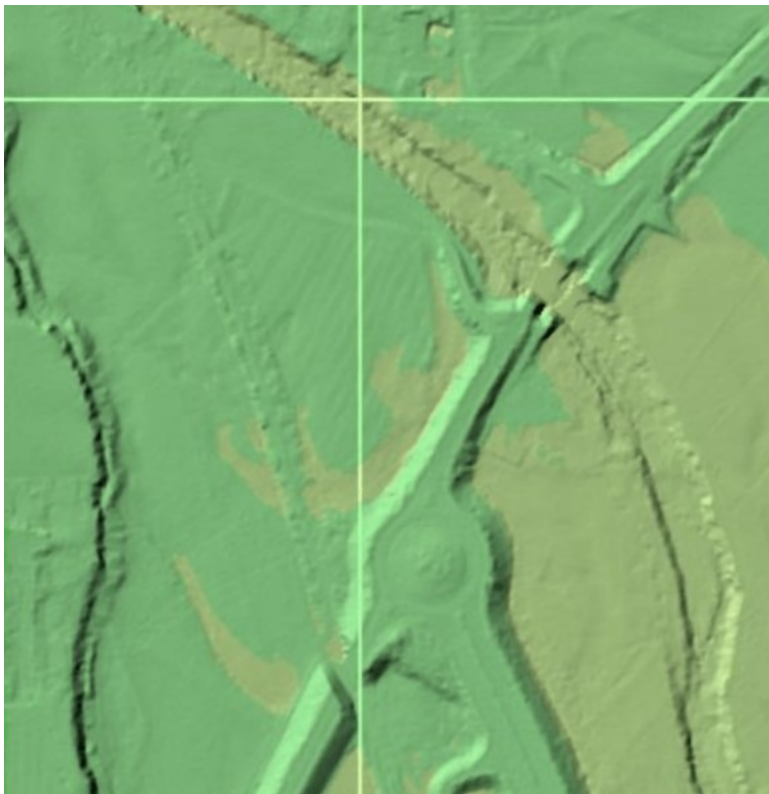

I have just checked the LiDAR on Data Map Wales as we don't have coverage of this area and note that there are well preserved ridge and furrow earthworks – the northern border form the parish boundary. I would recommend that planting takes place with minimal ground disturbance to retain the earthworks under a permanent woodland canopy. Best wishes

I am currently preparing a 0.8 ha Morewoods scheme at Derwydd for Woodland Trust for the site noted below and would be grateful for any information that may impact the landowners plans for planting.

Derwydd - GR SN430218 Land near Carmarthen. Planting will be irregular clumped planting with gaps to encourage natural regeneration from adjacent ASNW – 1600 trees/ha oak, birch, crab apple, hazel, hawthorn being the main species.
