
Subject: Llanwrda railway structure

We're planning a fish passage easement scheme at Llanwrda railway bridge (SN7169531226) scheduled for delivery in summer 2024. The works involve prebarrages to raise water levels at the base of the weir, replacing existing baulks to increase water depth over bridge apron, and installation of a eel/lamprey pass through the true right baulk. I've attached designs and method statement. The image below shows materials drop off point, access route, site compound and works footprint.
