PRN 9058 POST MEDIEVAL FARMSTEAD SN76206853


Ruined farmstead complex. RPS September 2001.

Series of field boundaries surrounding Pant y Gaseg farmstead (DAT 108934). 4 enclosed field boundaries and another partial boundary of a linear nature running west to south-east. Visible from AP. E.J.Stapley, 2/8/00.
