Castle Dock-Stackpole, Pembrokeshire**

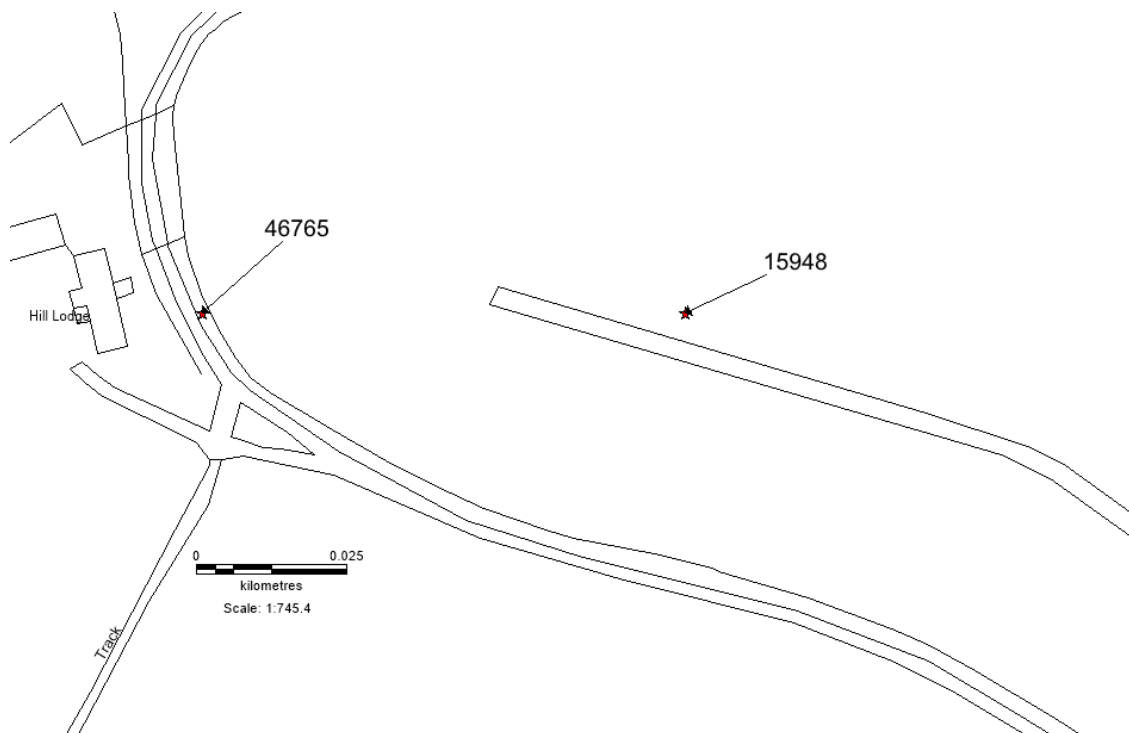
Thank you for your felling licence consultation. I have reviewed the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note that this application lies within the Grade I Registered Park and Garden of Stackpole Court PGW (Dy) 44 (PEM), therefore Cadw must be consulted. I am copying this response to Lisa Fiddes Inspector of Historic Parks and Gardens. In addition, I have also noted the following features recorded on the Historic Environment Record:

PRN15948 POST MEDIEVAL LODGE SR97499690

A lodge present on 1861 Ordnance Survey map. Condition unknown. MM based on KM 2003.

PRN46765 POST MEDIEVAL GATE SR97419690

Terrace 30m long and 10m wide to east of Hill Lodge, on which the lodge gates were located. Gate posts remain but gates removed. KM 2003.

We advise that these historic environment features (labelled on the maps above and marked with a red star or green polygon) are protected from damage during forest operations, to comply with UKFS Forests and the historic environment guidance.

The consultation also lies within the Historic Landscape Character Area of Stackpole Court <https://dyfedarchaeology.org.uk/HLC/stackpolewarren/stackpolecourt.htm>.

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified it is important that Dyfed Archaeological Trust Heritage Management is informed and further information and advice can then be provided as required.
