Protheroe-Jones gives two NGR's (SN746828 or 744818) neither of which seem accurate. SN746818 does denote a site near TYNYRHOS. P Sambrook 1993. An Old Level (Lead) is recorded on the 2nd Edition Ordnance Survey Map. Exact location and extent unclear.
