

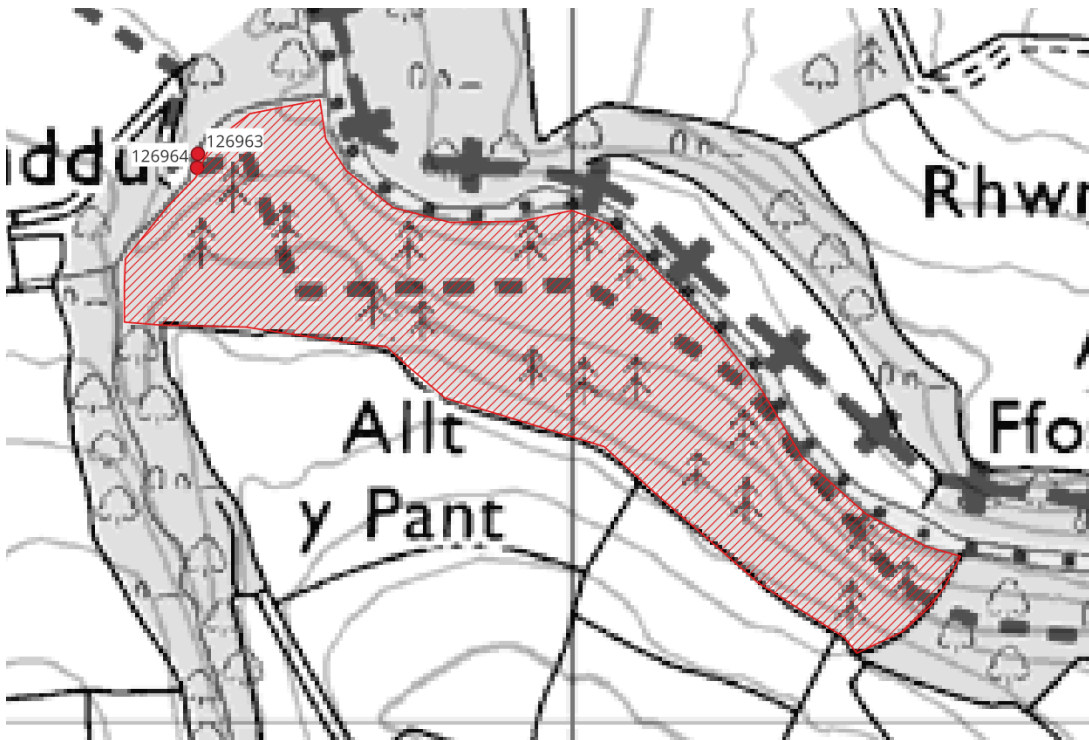

NRW Screening Request FLA10 24-25

Thank you for your consultation regarding the felling licence application for Edwinsford Estate. I have reviewed the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources. The following historic environment features are recorded within the consultation area:

- **Footbridge (PRN 126963):** Marked on the 1st and 2nd edition 1:2500 Ordnance Survey Maps (NGR: SN5876733355). This footbridge may survive as ruins, earthworks, or below ground archaeology.
- **Ford (PRN 126964):** Also marked on the 1st and 2nd edition 1:2500 Ordnance Survey Maps (NGR: SN5876633346). Similar to the footbridge, this ford may exist as ruins, earthworks, or below ground archaeology.
