Thank you for your consultation. I have checked the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note the following historic features.

PRN25837 **PWLL-GLAS POST MEDIEVAL METAL MINE** **SN6291286452**
Old Shaft (Lead) recorded on 2nd Edition Ordnance Survey Map. A. Powell 2024.

PRN130834 **LLANDRE POST MEDIEVAL BUILDING** **SN6292586285**
Building recorded on 2nd Edition Ordnance Survey Map. A. Powell 2024.

PRN130838 **LLANDRE BRONZE AGE STANDING STONE** **SN6297886252**
Standing stone in this location roughly 2.0m in height. J. Smith 2024.
A previously unrecorded standing stone roughly 2.0m high set on rising ground overlooking the Bow Street valley. Monoliths such as this are generally ascribed a Bronze Age date and are thought to be ritual monuments. Some stones are likely to be later and may be property or funerary markers. 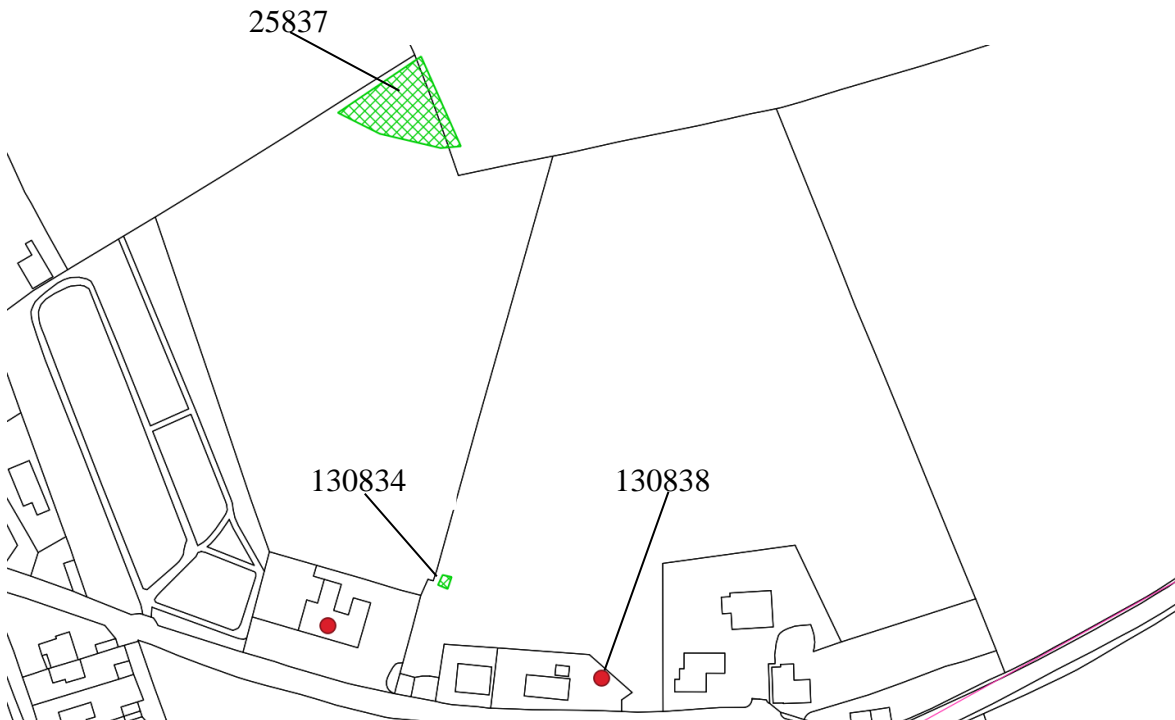
