PRN108321 POST MEDIEVAL MILESTONE SN25544219
A milestone on the Cardigan to Newcastle Emlyn turnpike road. Appears on Ordnance Survey 1st edition 1888 labelled "Cardigan 6". Also, on Ordnance Survey 2nd edition 1906 labelled the same.



The current condition of these features is unknown; however, they may survive as a ruins, earthworks or below ground archaeology. We advise that the historic environment features (labelled on the map above and marked with a red spot) are protected from damage during forest operations, to comply with UKFS Forests and the historic environment guidance.

The historic maps record this area as predominantly broadleaf woodlands. Therefore, any restocking should be with native broadleaf species.

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified it is important that Heneb – The Trust for Welsh Archaeology, Heritage Management Dyfed region is informed and further information and advice can then be provided as required.
